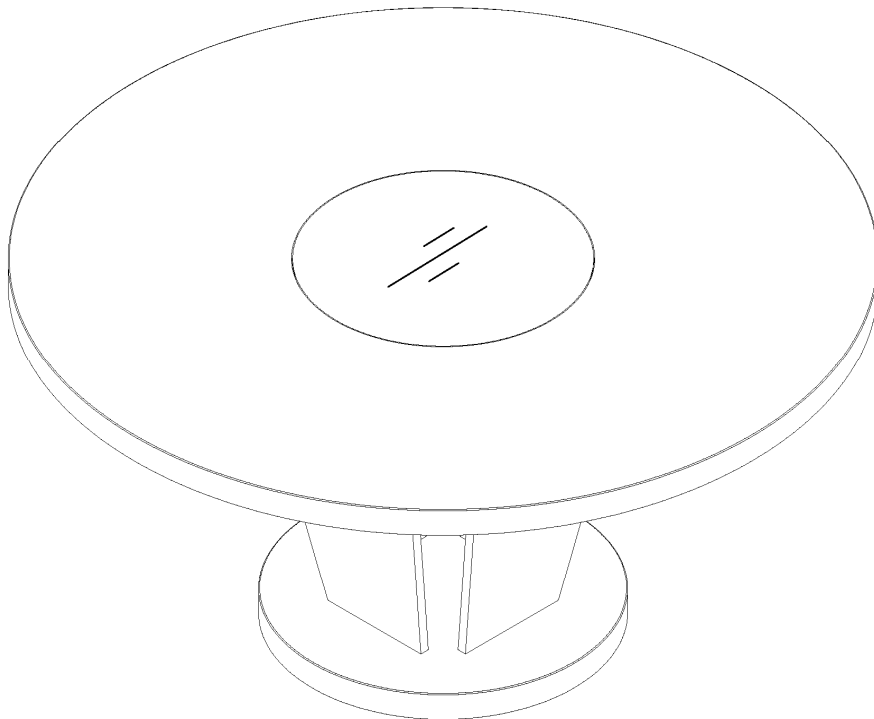

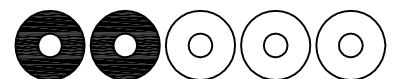

# PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



## Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



## Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



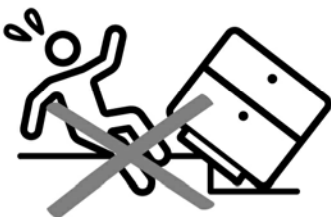
## Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



## Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.



## Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

# ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE



**FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES BELOW MAY RESULT IN INJURY AND/OR PROPERTY DAMAGE.**



Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes.



Turn clockwise to tighten and only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



Use the appropriate hand tools or power tools for assembly. Select steps, such as tightening screws and/or bolts, may require hand tools to avoid causing damage during assembly.



Save the instructions and store any supplied tools for later maintenance.



After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

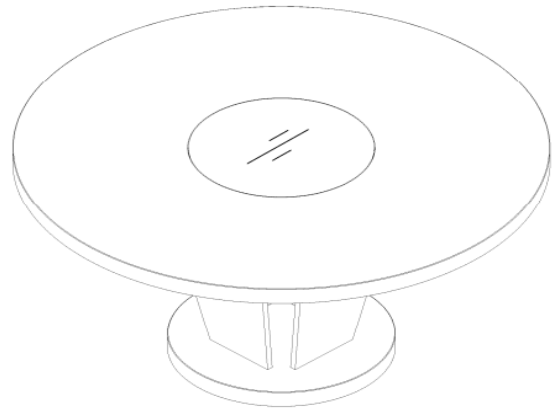

- I. Align the leg base (#2) with the pre-drilled holes of the leg panels (#3).
- II. Prepare 8 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#C) onto the bolt (#A) and then the flat washer (#B) onto the SAME bolt (#A), in that order.
- III. Insert the bolt assemblies through the pre-drilled holes on the leg base (#2) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#D) to lock them with the leg panels (#3).

Turn right (clockwise) to tighten

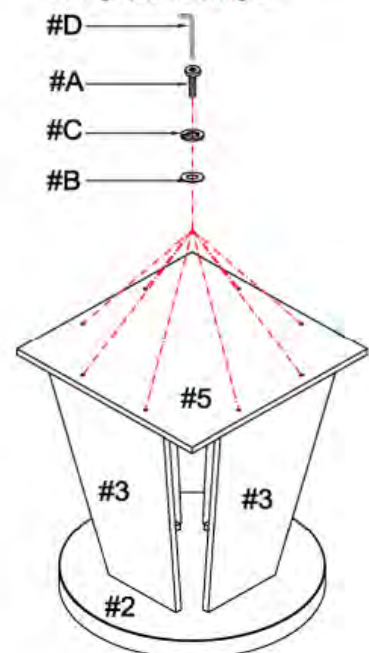

- I. Align the assembled leg panels (#3) in Step 1 with the pre-drilled holes of the table base (#5).
- II. Prepare 8 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#C) onto the bolt (#A) and then the flat washer (#B) onto the SAME bolt (#A), in that order.
- III. Insert the bolt assemblies through the pre-drilled holes on the table base (#5) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#D) to lock them with the leg panels (#3).

Turn right (clockwise) to tighten

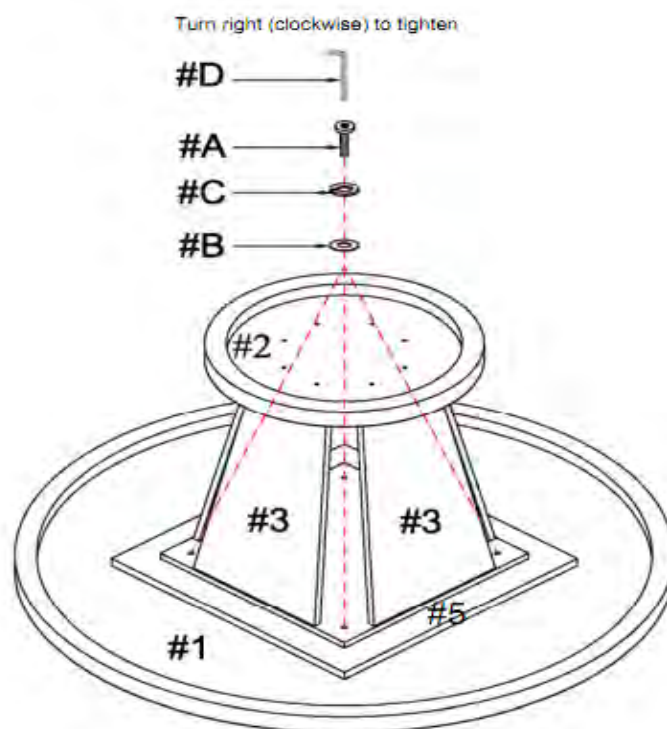
Part **#1** x1pc

Hardware **#A** x 4pcs

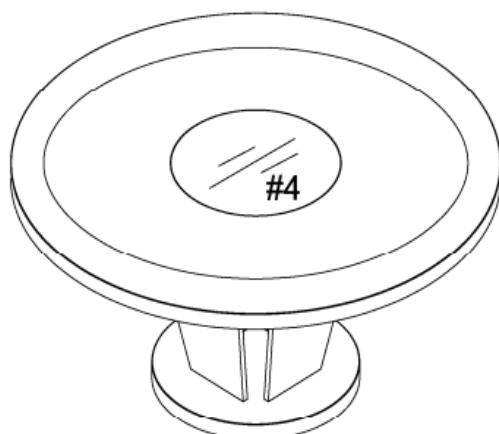
- I. Carefully place the table top (#1) facing down on a protected surface.
- II. Align the assembled table base (#5) in Step 2 with the pre-drilled holes on the bottom of the table top (#1)
- III. Prepare 4 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#C) onto the bolt (#A) and then the flat washer (#B) onto the SAME bolt (#A), in that order.
- IV. Insert the bolt assemblies through the pre-drilled holes of the table base (#5) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#D) to lock them in with the table top (#1).



## 4

Part **#4** x1pc

With the help of another person, carefully turn the table upright. Place the table glass (#4) onto the table top (#1). Make sure the table is rested on a flat surface and it does not feel loose or wobbly. If it does, double check that the bolts are secured and properly tighten.



### ASSEMBLY COMPLETED



Please ensure the furniture rests on an even and flat surface. If the product wobbles or feels loose, double-check all bolts and/or screws are properly tightened and secured.
