





Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.








Tool(s) required for assembly: Phillips screwdriver, Level, Drill (8 volts or less), 3/8" Drill Bit

- The unit must be level to work properly. Use the included adjustable levelers to level.


#### STEP 2


Attach Back Rail (H) to Side Panel (C) with Cam Lock. (See Figure 2)


Attach Back Upright (I) to Stretcher (H).

Slide Back Panels (J) into position.

Attach Back Rail (H) to unit with Cam Lock.








#### STEP 3

Attach Front Rails (F) and (G) to unit with Cam Locks.

Attach Side Panel (B) to unit with Cam Locks.

# STEP 6

Attach Back Stretcher (H) to Side Panel (D) with Cam Lock.


Attach Back Upright (I) to Stretcher (H).

Slide Back Panels (J) into position.

Attach Back Stretcher (H) to unit with Cam Lock.

Attach Front Stretcher (G) to Side Panel (D) with Cam Lock.


Attach Side Panel (E) to unit with Cam Locks.



#### STEP 7

Attach unit from Step 6 to unit from Step 5 with Cam Locks.






#### STEP 9

Slide Drawer Bottom (R5) into groove.


Attach Drawer Bottom (R5) to unit with Wood Screws (short).





#### STEP 10

Attach Handles with Machine Screws.

#### **STEP 11**

Insert Adjustable Pins into side panels at desired level.


Place Shelves (M) into position.

Slide Drawer (R) into position.

Attach Doors (N) and (O) to unit by sliding door hinges into side panel hinges.

Attach Knobs to Doors (N) and (O) with Machine Screws.

Attach Top (A) to unit with Cam Locks.




Level unit by adjusting the adjustable levelers on bottom of unit. (See Figure 5)

Note: Unit must be level to proceed.

Insert Wood Screws (short) into pre-drilled holes in unit, then tighten.

**STEP 12** 

Note: Unit must be level before tightening these screws.



#### Assembly Instructions 8/8

#### **IMPORTANT**

• To help reduce the risk of the unit tipping over, the Tipover Restraint must be installed following these instructions exactly.

#### **STEP 13**

Place unit at desired location.

Drill a 3/8" hole in wall in-line with pre-drilled hole at top of unit.

Move unit.

Insert Anchor into the wall hole and attach Bracket with Wall Screw.

Attach Bracket at pre-drilled hole at top of unit with Wood Screw.

Move unit back into place.

Slide Tipover Restraint through Bracket on wall and Bracket on unit. (See Figure 6)

Put tie end of Tipover Restraint into lock end of Tipover Restraint and pull until tight.




