7) Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.

8) Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding-type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. The wide blade or the third pin provides your protection. If the provided plug does not fit into your outlet, consult an electrician for replacement of the obsolete outlet.

10) Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.

Installing the LCD Monitor against a wall or enclosed area Ventilation

Installed with stand:
4 inches (10 cm) 11 1/2 inches (30 cm) 4 inches (10 cm) 2 1/2 inches (6 cm)
Leave at least this much space around the set.

Installed on the wall:

Never install the LCD Monitor as follows:

If damage occurs to the LCD panel, small traces of liquid crystal sandwiched between the glass may be found on the surface.
