
Initial commissioning

Operation

Before using the tumble dryer for the first time, ensure that it is correctly installed and connected.



It is essential to read the operating instruct tions.



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Display

The sensor buttons 2, 4, 6 and 7 react to fingertip contact. Selection is possible as long as the respective sensor button is illuminated.

- If a sensor button is brightly lit, this means: currently selected
- If a sensor button is dimly lit, this means: selection possible
- Sensor buttons for the drying levels After a drying level program is selected with the program selector, the proposed drying level lights up.

- After touching the I sensor button, a later start time for the program (Delay Start) can be selected.
- The < or > sensor buttons are used for selecting the duration of the delay start period or the duration of the Time Drv program.
- Start/Stop sensor button Touching the Start/Stop sensor button starts the selected program or cancels a program that has already been started. The sensor button flashes slowly as soon as it is possible for a program to be started and then lights up constantly after the program has started.

Energy saving tips

To avoid unnecessarily long drying times and high consumption of energy:


- Make sure your laundry is spun at the maximum spin speed before drying.
- Load according to the optimum amount of laundry recommended for the program being used. This will mean that the energy consumption for the amount of laundry is at its most economical.
- Clean the lint filters after every drying
- Make sure the room temperature is not too high.

If there are other heat producing appliances in the room in which the tumble dryer is located, make sure the room is well-ventilated and switch the other appliances off, if possible.

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- Remove foreign objects like detergent dispensing
- Check seams and stitching to ensure that padding and
- Fasten duvet covers and pillow cases to prevent small
- Tie together textile belts and apron ties.

- Open the door.
- Unfold the laundry and load looselv into the drum.
- Do not overload the drum. Overloading can cause unnecessary wear and tear to the laundry, give a disappointing drying result and cause more creasing.
- If you are not using a fragrance flacon: The tab must be pushed down completely (see
- When closing the door, make sure that laundry does not get trapped in the door opening.
- Shut the door with a gentle swing.



Selecting a program

- Turn the program selector.
- A drving level may light up and durations will appear on the time display

Touch the > sensor button repeatedly until the required program duration appears on the time display. You can set the duration in ten-minute increments from 0:20 minutes to 2:00 h.

■ You can change the time with the < sensor button.

Selecting *Gentle* (if necessary)

Delicate fabrics (with the 🖸 symbol on the care label, e.g., acrylic garments) are dried at a lower temperature and the program duration is longer.

Touch the Gentle sensor button. It will then light up brightly.

Selecting Delay Start (if necessary) You can delay the start of a program

from 0:30 minutes up to 24 h. Delay Start cannot be used with the Time



Dry program.

Touch the 🔿 sensor button. 🗇 will light up brightly.



Touch the < or > sensor button repeatedly until the required delayed st time appears on the time display.

Starting a program

Touch the flashing Start/Stop sensor button. The Start/Stop sensor button will light up.

Energy savings:

After 10 minutes, the indicators dim and the Start/Stop sensor button starts flashing.

Touch the Start/Stop sensor button to switch the indicators on again (this doe not have any effect on a running program).

Clean the lint filters. Close the drum door.



4. Removing the laundry at the end of the program

End of program: 0:00 lights up and the *Start/Stop* sensor button goes out: - Energy savings: 10 minutes after the end of the program, the *Start/Stop* sensor button will begin to flash and the display will go out.

- The dryer will switch off automatically 15 minutes after the end of the Anticrease phase (with programs without an anticrease phase, it will switch off 15 minutes after the end of the program)...

Only open the door when the drying process has finished..



Open the door. Remove the laundry

Check that all items have been removed from the drum. If items are left in the dryer, they could be damaged by overdrying when the dryer is next used.





Cancelling the current program

- Touch the *Start/Stop* sensor button. The items will be cooled down. depending on the temperature reached and how long they have been dried for. 0:00 will light up if you press the Start/ Stop sensor button again during the cooling-down phase.
- Turn the program selector to the ⁽⁾ position.
- To prevent water from running out, keep aram.

Adding or removing laundry


Program duration

Tip: Using a fragrance flacon will add a pleasant fragrance to your laundry.



Inserting a fragrance flacon






Markers (1) and (2) must line up with one another.



Turn the outer ring clockwise a little.





Remove the fragrance flacon (reverse points 3 and 4) and store it in its original packaging.



Never lav the fragrance flacon down on any surface as the fragrance will spill


Removing visible lint

Clean both lint filters in the door opening after every drying cycle.

Remove the fragrance flacon (if fitted).








Push the upper lint filter back into position until it clicks. Close the door.
