

PRECAUTIONS TO AVOID POSSIBLE EXPOSURE TO EXCESSIVE MICROWAVE ENERGY

- (a) Do not attempt to operate this oven with the door open since open-door operation can result in harmful exposure to microwave energy. It is important not to defeat or tamper with the safety interlocks.
- **(b)** Do not place any object between the oven front face and the door or allow soil or cleaner residue to accumulate on sealing surfaces.
- **(c)** Do not operate the oven if it is damaged. It is particularly important that the oven door close properly and that there is no damage to the: (1) door (bent), (2) hinges and latches (broken or loosened), (3) door seals and sealing surfaces.
- (d) The oven should not be adjusted or repaired by anyone except properly qualified service personnel.

IMPORTANT Read all instructions carefully before installation and operation. Keep this Operation Manual for future use. Sharp Microwave Drawer $^{\text{\tiny M}}$ Oven is manufactured in compliance with the relevant safety standard.

AWARNING Failure to follow these warnings could result in a fire or explosion causing property damage, personal injury or death. To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, exposure to excessive microwave energy or injury, use only as intended and take the following precautions.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

AWARNING When using electrical appliances, take safety precautions, including the following:

- 1 Install or locate this unit only in accordance with the provided installation instructions.
- 2 Read all instructions before using Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven.
- **3** Read and follow specific PRECAUTIONS TO AVOID POSSIBLE EXPOSURE TO EXCESSIVE MICROWAVE ENERGY on page 2.
- **4** Do not store or use this appliance outdoors or in areas near water, such as near a kitchen sink, in a wet basement, near a swimming pool or similar locations.
- 5 Do not immerse the cord in water. Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- **6** To prevent accidents and achieve optimal ventilation, ensure sufficient space around the cooking area.
- 7 HOT CONTENTS CAN CAUSE SEVERE BURNS. DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN TO USE THE MICROWAVE OVEN. Use caution when removing hot items.
- 8 Use the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven only for its intended purpose as described in this manual. This appliance is designed for built-in household use only. Do not use outdoors. Do not use to heat a room. Do not use corrosive chemicals or vapors in this appliance. This appliance is specifically designed to heat, cook or dry food. It is not designed for industrial or laboratory use.
- **9** Do not store or use flammable or combustible materials, gasoline or other flammable vapors and liquids in the vicinity of this appliance.
- 10 Use caution when removing hot items.
- 11 Use only dry potholders. Moist or damp potholders on hot surfaces may cause burns from steam. Do not let potholders touch hot surfaces or radiant surface units. Do not use towels or other bulky cloth.
- **12** Keep fingers and clothes clear of drawer guides when the drawer is opened or closed. Fingers or clothes could be caught in the guides when the drawer is closed.
- **13** Have the installer identify the location of the circuit breaker or fuse. Mark it for easy reference.
- **14** Before performing any service, disconnect the appliance power supply at the household distribution panel by removing the fuse or switching off the circuit breaker.

- 15 Do not repair or replace any part of Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven unless specifically recommended in this manual. All other servicing should be referred to a qualified technician.
- **16** Some products in sealed containers, such as whole eggs and closed glass jars, can explode and should not be heated in the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven.
- 17 To reduce risk of fire in the oven cavity, take the following precautions.
 - Do not overcook food. Carefully attend the appliance when paper, plastic or other combustible materials are used to facilitate cooking in the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven.
 - Remove wire twist-ties from paper or plastic bags before placing bag in oven cavity.
 - If materials inside the Sharp Microwave Drawer[™] Oven ignite, keep the drawer closed, turn off the appliance and shut off power at the fuse or circuit breaker panel.
 - Do not use Sharp Microwave Drawer[™] Oven for storage purposes. Do not leave paper products, cooking utensils or food in the oven cavity when not in use.
- **18** Food and containers must be shorter in height than the drawer. Refer to the height of the side walls of the drawer.
- **19** Use only mild, nonabrasive soaps or detergents applied with a sponge or soft cloth when cleaning the sealing surfaces that come together on closing the drawer.
- 20 Liquids, such as water, coffee or tea, can be overheated beyond the boiling point without appearing to boil, due to surface tension of the liquid. Visible bubbling or boiling when the container is removed from the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven is not always present. This could result in VERY HOT LIQUIDS suddenly boiling over when a spoon or other utensil is inserted into the liquid.

To reduce the risk of injury to persons when heating liquids:

- Do not overheat liquids.
- Stir liquids both before and halfway through heating.
- Do not use straight-sided containers with narrow necks. Use wide-mouthed containers.
- After heating allow the container to stand in the Sharp Microwave Drawer[™] Oven for at least 20 seconds before removing.
- Use extreme care when inserting a spoon or other utensil into liquids after heating.
- 21 If the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven light fails, consult a Sharp Authorized Servicer. Only qualified service personnel should service Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven. Contact 1-800-BE-SHARP for the nearest Sharp Authorized Servicer for evaluation, repair and/or adjustment.

TIME COOKING

HIGH POWER COOKING

- 1 Touch **number** pads to enter cooking time.
- 2 Touch START/+30 SEC pad for 100% power. The timer on the display counts down.

VARIABLE POWER COOKING

- 1 Touch number pads to enter time.
- **2** Touch **Power Level** pad repeatedly to select power level.
- 3 Touch START/+30 SEC pad.

SENSOR COOK

- 1 Touch Cook pad.
- 2 Touch a number pad to select food item.
- 3 Touch START/+30 SEC pad.
- **4** Once cooking is complete, instructions such as *STIR LET STAND COVERED* appear on the screen, depending on the food item.

DEFROST

The Defrost feature uses lower power level to gently defrost foods shown on the menu label.

- 1 Touch **Defrost** pad.
- 2 Touch number pads to select food item.
- 3 Touch number pads to enter weight.
- 4 Touch START/+30 SEC pad.
- 5 The oven will pause so the food can be checked. Open the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven and follow instructions on the display.
- 6 Touch START/+30 SEC pad.
- 7 After each audible signal, turn the food over and touch START/+30 SEC pad again.

BEVERAGE

Use the Beverage feature to reheat coffee or tea to a suitable drinking temperature or make instant coffee, tea or hot cereal.

- 1 Touch Beverage pad
- 2 Touch a number pad to select food item.
- 3 Touch the same **number** pad repeatedly to increase quantity.
- 4 Touch START/+30 SEC pad.

NOTE: After heating, stir beverage again.

MORE MENUS

MELT/SOFTEN/WARM

- 1 Touch More menus pad.
- 2 Touch a number pad to select food item.
- **3** Repeat touching the same **number** pad to select quantity.
- 4 Touch START/+30 SEC pad.

ROLLS/MUFFINS

The Rolls/Muffins feature can be used to warm rolls, muffins, biscuits or bagels from room temperature, refrigerated or frozen.

- **1** Arrange rolls on a plate and cover with a paper towel.
- 2 Touch More Menus pad.
- **3** Touch a **number** pad to select food item.
- 4 Touch **number** pads to enter quantity.
- 5 Touch START/+30 SEC.

KEEP WARM

Use the Keep Warm feature to keep food warm for up to 30 minutes. The feature can be used directly or in sequence with timed cooking.

DIRECT USE

- 1 Touch More Menus pad.
- 2 Touch 9 to select Keep Warm.
- **3** Touch **number** pads to enter desired warming time in minutes and seconds. To warm for 30 minutes, touch **3-0-0-0**.
- 4 Touch START/+30 SEC. The oven will start, and the display will show the timer counting down with KEEP WARM appearing intermittently.

KEEP WARM AFTER TIMED COOK

- 1 Touch **number** pads to enter cook time in minutes and seconds.
- **2** If necessary, set the power level by touching **Power Level** pad repeatedly until the correct level is displayed.
- 3 Touch More Menus pad.
- 4 Touch 9 to select Keep Warm.
- 5 Touch number pads to enter desired warming time in minutes and seconds.
- **6** Touch **START/+30 SEC** pad. The timed cooking will start. When cooking is complete, a long tone will sound and the Keep Warm feature will start. The display will show the timer counting down with KEEP WARM appearing intermittently during count down.

QUICK START GUIDE

CONTROL LOCK

The Control Lock prevents unwanted drawer operation such as by small children. The Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven can be set so the control panel and the automatic door mechanism are deactivated or locked.

TO LOCK

Touch and hold for 3 seconds.

TO UNLOCK

Touch and hold pad for 3 seconds.

HELP/SETTINGS

Check operation manual for specific details.

Touch Help/Settings pad:

- 4 times for Auto Start. Then touch START/+30 SEC pad.
- 5 times for Demo Mode. Then touch **START/+30 SEC** pad.
- 8 times for Sound On/Off. Then touch START/+30 SEC pad.
- 9 times for End of Cooking Reminder On/Off. Then touch START/+30 SEC pad.

SET THE CLOCK

- 1 Touch Timer/Clock pad.
- 2 Touch 2 pad to set clock.
- 3 Use number pads to enter time of day.
- 4 Touch Timer/Clock pad to accept entered time of day.

TIMER

To set the timer:

- 1 Touch Timer/Clock pad.
- 2 Touch 1 pad to set the timer.
- **3** Use **number** pads to enter time. The time counts down.
- **4** Touch **STOP/CLEAR** pad to cancel the timer. An audible signal will sound when the countdown completes.

CLEARANCES AND DIMENSIONS


Do not install this appliance in any combustible cabinetry, which is not in accord with the stated clearances and dimensions on pages 2–5. See Figures 1–7.

SAFELY LIFT AND MOVE UNIT

Two people are required to safely lift and move this unit.

UNPACKING THE APPLIANCE

 Remove all packing materials from inside the Sharp Microwave Drawer[™] Oven. DO NOT REMOVE THE WAVEGUIDE COVER, which is located on the top of the Sharp Microwave Drawer[™] Oven.



Remove the protective film from the touch control area. Additionally, remove the feature sticker, if there is one. Check the drawer for any damage, such as misaligned or bent drawer, damaged drawer seals and sealing surfaces, broken or loose drawer guides and dents inside the cavity or on the front side of the drawer. If there is any damage, do not operate the Sharp Microwave Drawer[™] Oven and contact your dealer or a Sharp authorized servicer.

IMPORTANT NOTES TO THE INSTALLER

- Read the entire Installation Manual before installing the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven.
- Remove all packing material before connecting the electrical supply. Manually pull open the drawer to ensure all packing material is removed prior to connection and installation.
- Observe all governing codes and ordinances.
- Leave these instructions with the consumer.

IMPORTANT NOTES TO THE CONSUMER

Keep this manual with your Operation Manual for future reference.

- Read and follow the safety precautions listed in the operation manual.
- Ensure your Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven is installed and grounded properly by a qualified installer or service technician.

- This appliance must be electrically grounded in accordance with local codes.
- Ensure the wall coverings and the cabinets around the appliance can withstand the heat generated by the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven.

A WARNING Never leave children alone or unattended in the area where the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven is in use. Never leave the drawer open when the appliance is unattended.

A WARNING Stepping, leaning or sitting on the drawer may result in serious injuries and can also cause damage to the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven.

- Do not use the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven as a storage space, as this creates a potentially hazardous situation.
- Check that the time-of-day is in the display. If not, touch STOP/ CLEAR for safety reasons and to prevent unintended use.


CLEARANCES AND DIMENSIONS

- Dimensions shown in Figure 1 must be used. Given dimensions provide minimum clearance. Locate electrical outlet in the shaded area in the upper left-hand corner of the cutout. See Figure 9.
- Contact surface must be solid and level. Pay special attention to the floor on which the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven will sit. The floor of the opening should be constructed of plywood strong enough to support the weight of the oven (about 100 pounds).
- Check location where the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven will be installed for proper electrical supply.
- If installing below a wall oven, ensure the clearance of the floor between the wall oven and the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven is a minimum of 2".
- The oven can also be mounted flush. See page 4 for flush mounting instructions.

Your oven can be built into a cabinet or wall as a stand-alone unit.
 It can be installed under gas or electric wall ovens and the Sharp Combi Steam Oven/Wall Oven Models ovens or under the Sharp cooktops listed below.



Figures 1 and 2 contain many measurements for reference when planning the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven location.

* Can also be installed using an electrical outlet in an adjacent cabinet within the area where the provided electrical cord can reach. Power cord access hole in cabinet should be a minimum 1¹/2" diameter hole and deburred of all sharp edges.

IMPORTANT Always allow sufficient power cord length to the electrical outlet to prevent tension.

Always check electrical codes for requirements.

Figure 3 represents a typical standard cabinet. If installed in custom cabinets with extended countertops, take into account visibility and access to controls. See Figure 4.






ANTI-TIP BLOCK

NORMAL INSTALLATION STEPS

ANTI-TIP BLOCK INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of tipping of the drawer, the Anti-Tip block must be properly installed located 14¹³/16" above the floor on which the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven will sit. The 6" Anti-Tip block must be provided by the installer. See Figure 1. The Anti-Tip block prevents serious injury that might result from spilled hot liquids.

If the Sharp Microwave DrawerTM Oven is ever moved to a different location, the Anti-Tip block must also be moved and installed. When installed to the wall, ensure the screws completely penetrate the drywall and are secured in wood or metal so the block is totally stable. When fastening, ensure the screws do not penetrate electrical wiring or plumbing.



ELECTRICAL OUTLET

The electrical requirements are a 120 volt 60 Hz, AC only, 15 amp. or more protected electrical supply. It is recommended that a separate circuit serving only this appliance be provided.

The drawer is equipped with a 3-prong grounding plug. It must be plugged into a properly installed and grounded wall receptacle. Should you only have a 2-prong outlet, have a qualified electrician install a correct wall receptacle.

Note: If you have any questions about the grounding or electrical instructions, consult a qualified electrician or serviceperson.





GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

This appliance must be grounded. The Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven is equipped with a cord having a grounding wire with a grounding plug. It must be plugged into a properly installed and grounded wall receptacle in accordance with the National Electrical Code and local codes and ordinances. In the event of an electrical short circuit, grounding reduces risk of electric shock by providing an escape wire for the electric current.

A WARNING Improper use of the grounding plug can result in a risk of electric shock. Do not use an extension cord. If the power supply cord is too short, have a qualified electrician or serviceman install an outlet near the appliance.



DRAWER INSTALLATION

- 1. Place the drawer adjacent to the wall or cabinet opening. Plug the power supply cord into the electrical outlet.
- 2. Carefully guide the drawer into the prepared opening. Avoid pinching the cord between the oven and the wall.
- 3. Slide the drawer all the way until the mounting flange is flush with the face of the cabinet. See Figure 10.
- 4. Open the drawer. Using the 4 holes on the drawer as a template, pre-drill the cabinet using a 1/16" bit. See Figure 10.
- 5. Secure the drawer with the 4 screws supplied. See Figure 11.





MODEL AND SERIAL NUMBER LOCATION

The nameplate includes model and serial number. Open the Sharp Microwave Drawer™ Oven fully. The label is beyond the back wall of the microwave cavity facing up from the flat surface.

CARE, CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

ACCESSORIES

UNDER THE COUNTER MICROWAVE DRAWER™ PEDESTAL SKMD24U0ES

Complete the installation with a two-drawer installation pedestal that comes with sleek, stainless-steel drawer fronts. For a unified look, the pedestal accepts custom front drawer panels.
