


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



Assembly Instructions, #9261 Claudette Three Shelf Bookcase

A packet with complete set of hardware can be found by pulling the red ribbon that's easily visible upon opening the box.




Step 1

- 1.1) Lay the left side frame (A) on a soft surface, insert the back gallery (C) into left side frame's tube, fasten with 1 bolt and flat washer.
- 1.2) Fit the metal part of the bottom panel (E) to the left side panel's tube, fasten with 1 bolt and flat washer.
- 1.3) Fasten the top panel and bottom panel (D and E) to the left side frame's tabs. Fasten with 2 screws at the bottom of each panel first, and 2 each at the back. Make sure not to leave any gap between the panel's ends and metal frame while tightening the screws.




Step 2

- 2.1) Insert the tubes of the right side frame (B) to the ends of back gallery (C) and bottom shelf (E).
- 2.2) Push to make sure both tubes are properly inserted. Fasten with 2 bolts and washers (1 at lower end of back gallery, 1 at lower front of bottom shelf). Fasten the top panel and bottom panel (D and E) to the right side frame's tabs with 2 screws at the bottom of each panel first, and 2 each at the back. Make sure not to leave any gap between the panel's ends and metal frame while tightening the screws.



Step 3

- 3.1) Place the assembled piece upright. Screw-in shelf supports (J) to the threaded holes on the inner face of the side frames.
- 3.2) Place the adjustable shelf (F) above the shelf supports, centering with even gaps between ends and the metal frames both sides.



Step 4

- 4.1) Adjust levelers at the bottom of legs if needed.
- 4.2) Fasten one part of the anti-tipping kit onto the pre-drilled holes at back panel and another part into the wall. Loop the strap through the holes of the fastened parts and pull its end to tighten.
