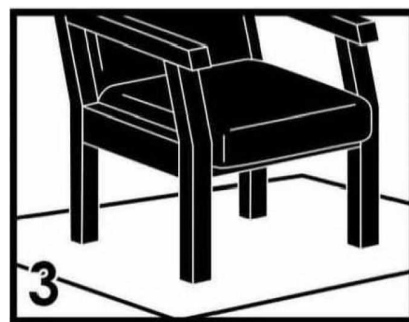
## BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



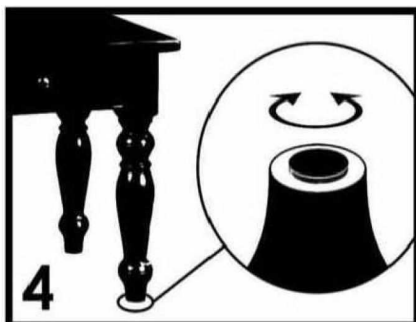
When lock or spring washer is used in an assembly, please make sure the lock or spring washer is placed between the larger flat washer and the head of the screw or bolt.



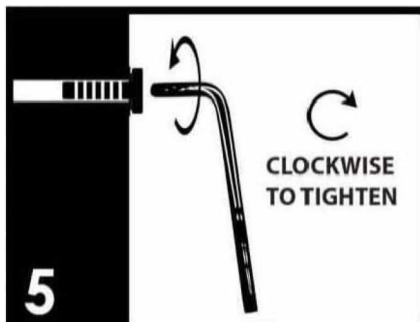
Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



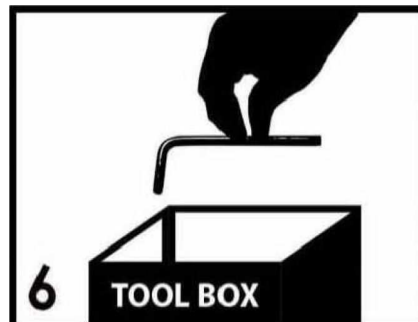
Use cardboard or carpet area when assembling furniture to prevent scratches. Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor. No dragging of products/parts.



Some furniture comes with height adjustment knobs underneath each leg. To lower or to raise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.

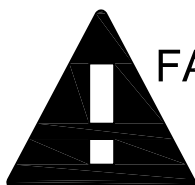


Make sure all parts are properly aligned, then use the appropriate hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or screws. Do not use power tools and do not overtighten.

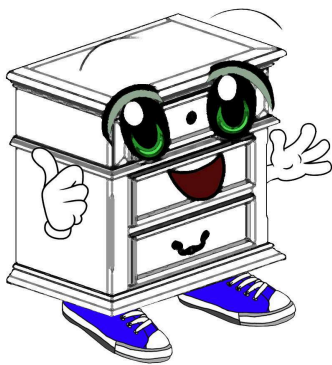


Save the instructions and store the Allen wrench or any supplied tool for later maintenance. After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES ABOVE MAY RESULT IN INJURY AND/OR PROPERTY DAMAGE.

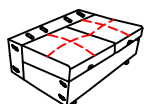

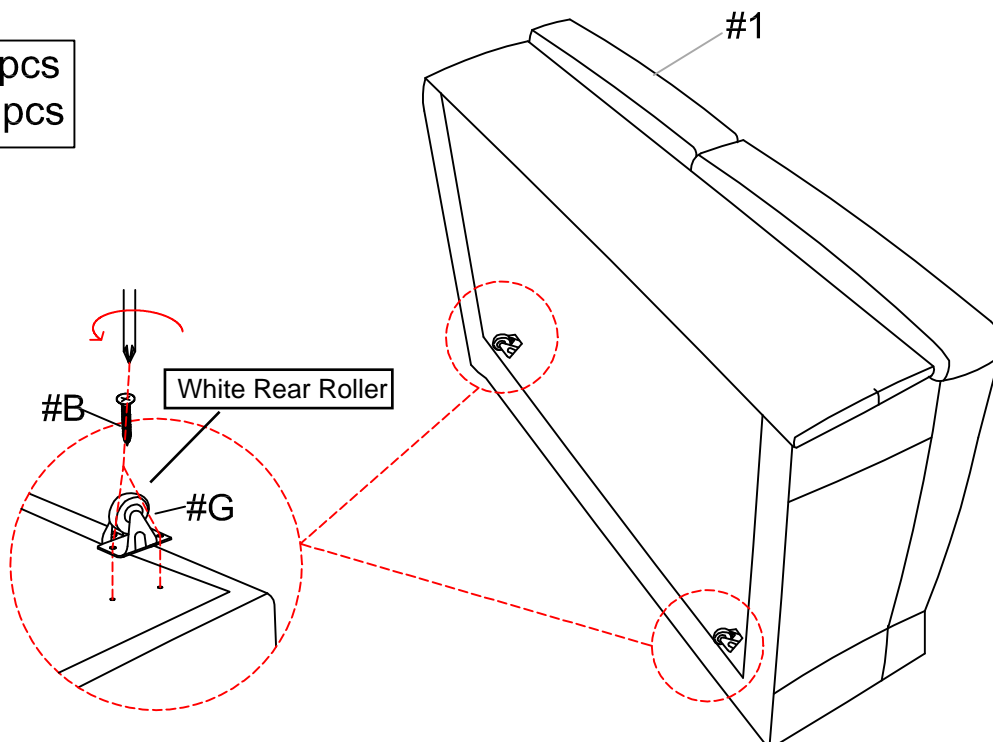
Cut the strap that holds the loveseat frame and extension together.

Align the white rear rollers (#G) to the bottom of the loveseat frame (#1), then secure by using screws (#B).

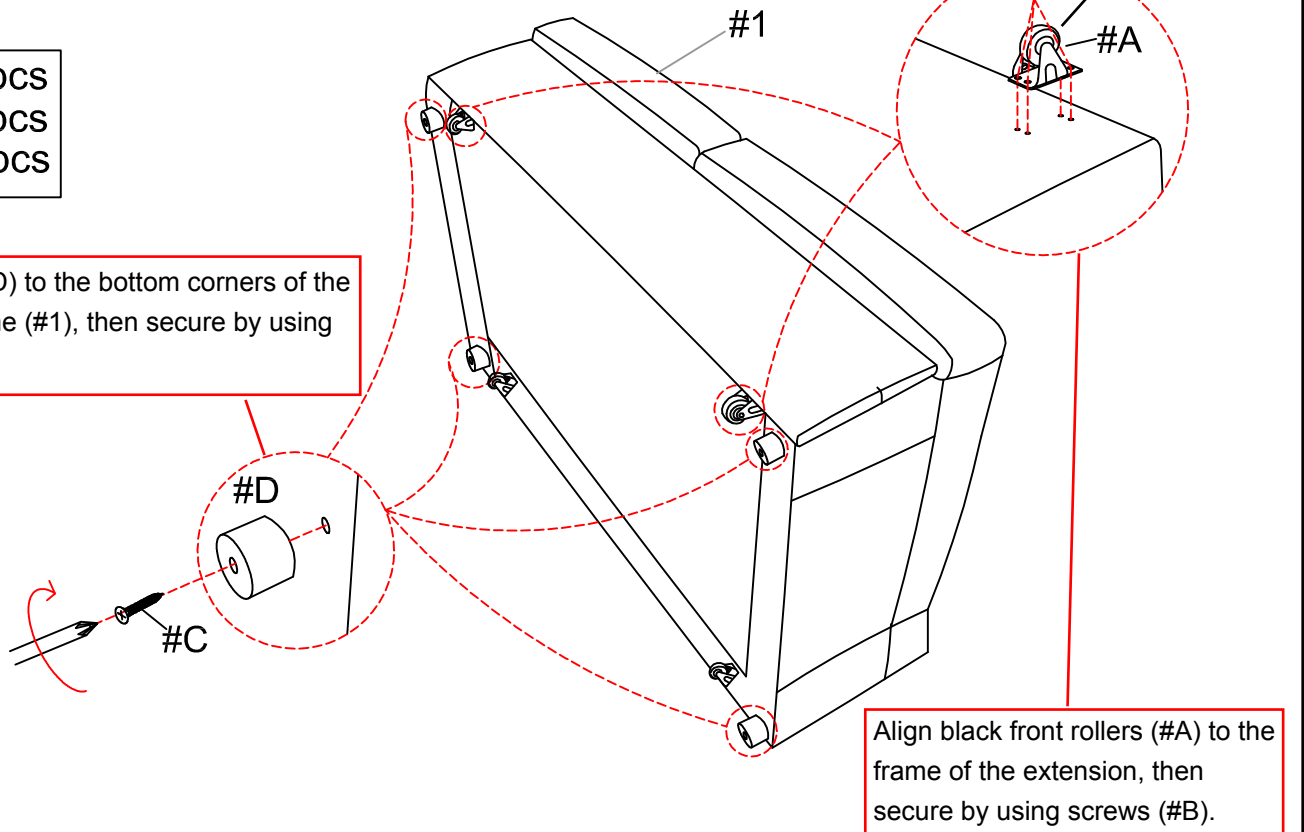




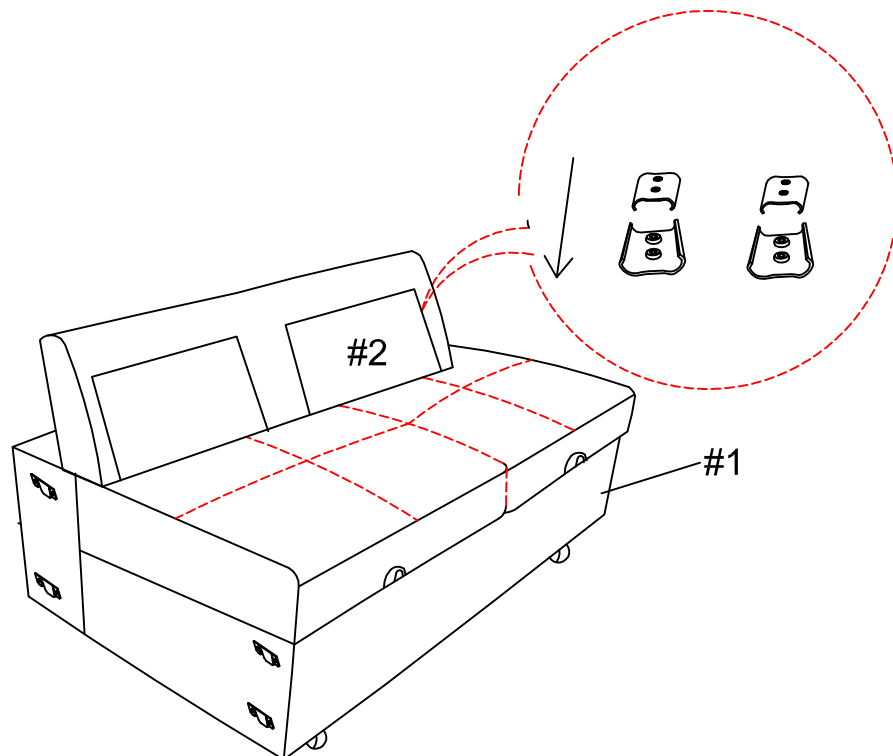

Align and attach the metal brackets of the back frame (#2) to the metal brackets of the loveseat frame (#1).

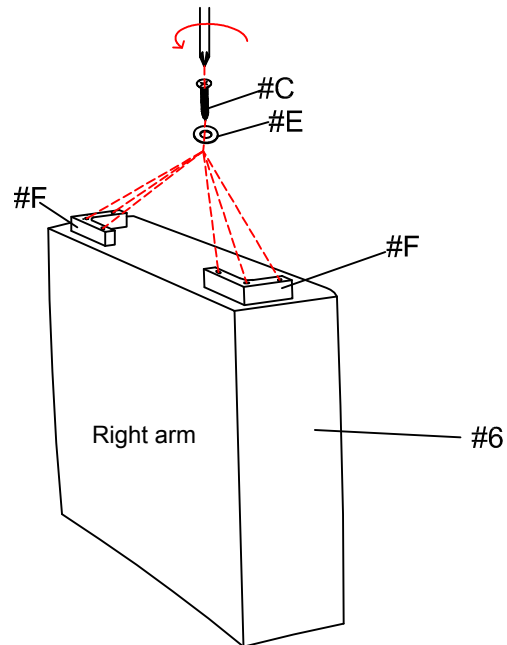
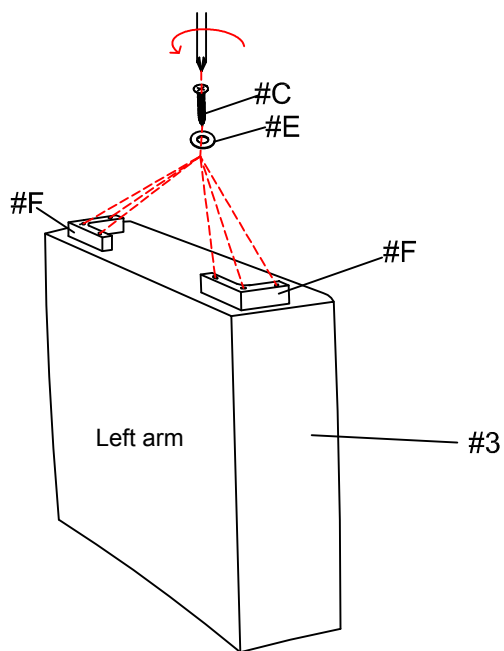

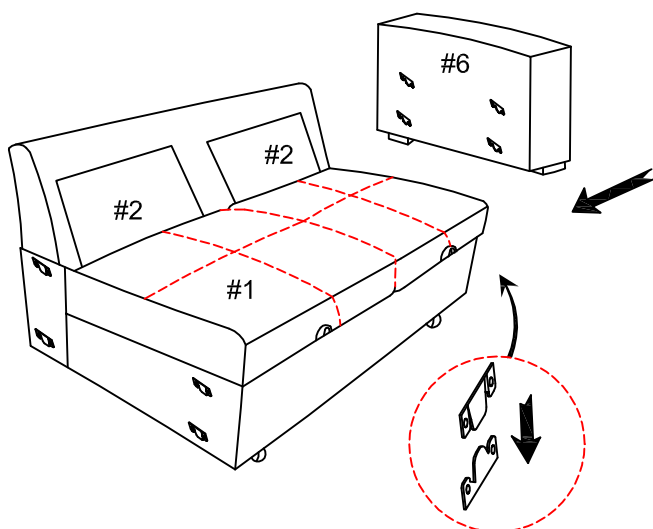
Align legs (#F) to the left and right arms (#3,6), then secure by using screws (#C) with washers (#E).

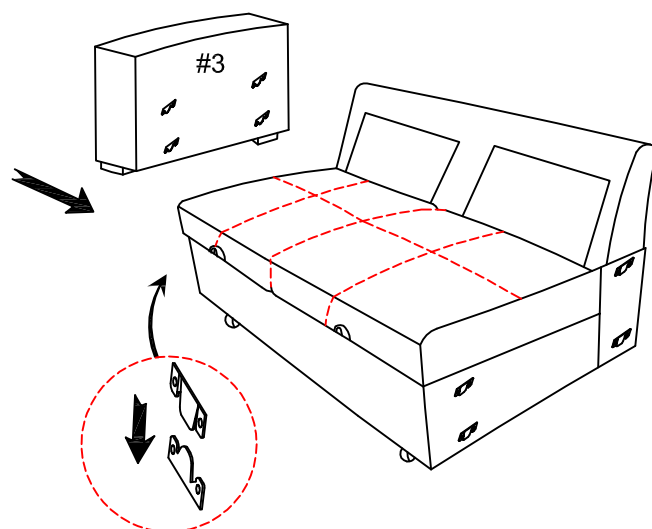


You have two options on how you want your product to be oriented.

Sofa on the right side assembly



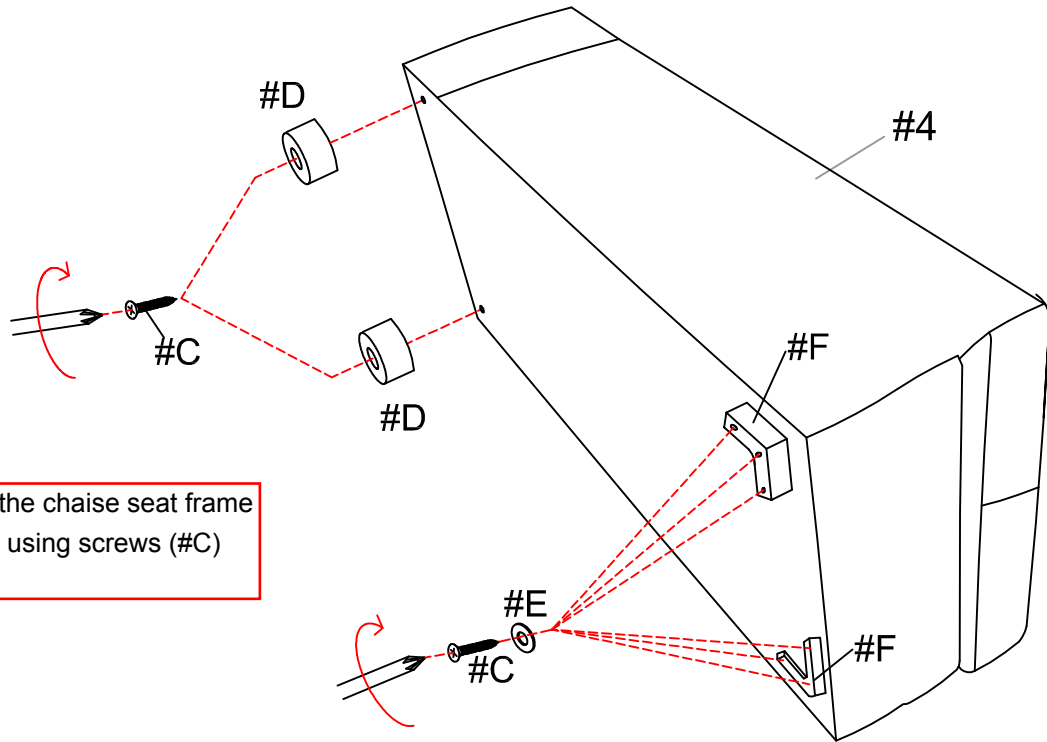
Sofa on the left side assembly

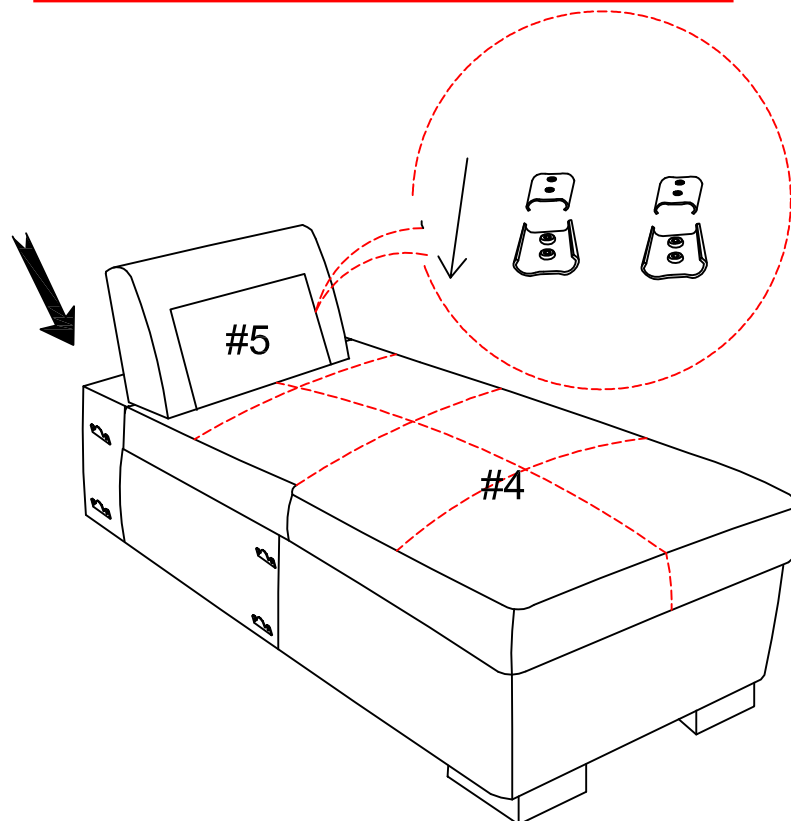

Align legs (#D,F) to the chaise seat frame (#4), then secure by using screws (#C) and washers (#E).



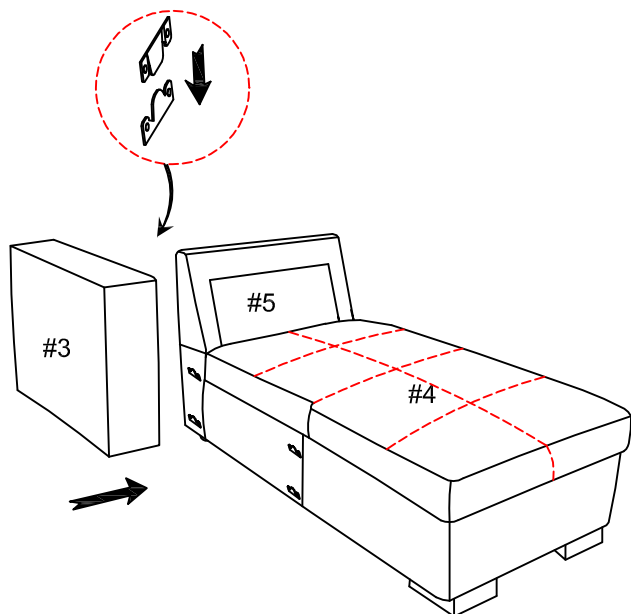
Align and attach the metal brackets of the back frame (#5) to the metal brackets of the chaise frame (#4).



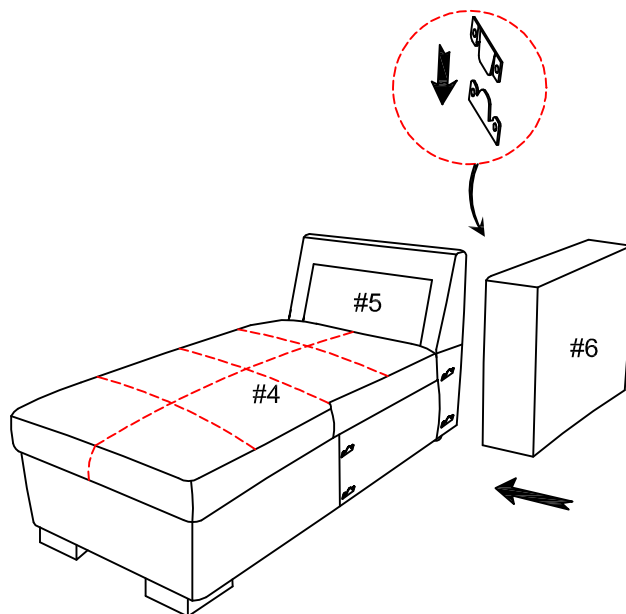

### Chaise on the left side assembly

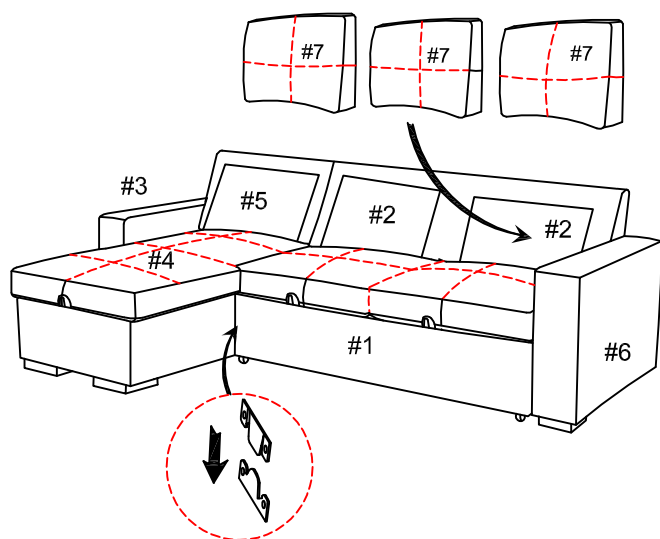


### Chaise on the right side assembly

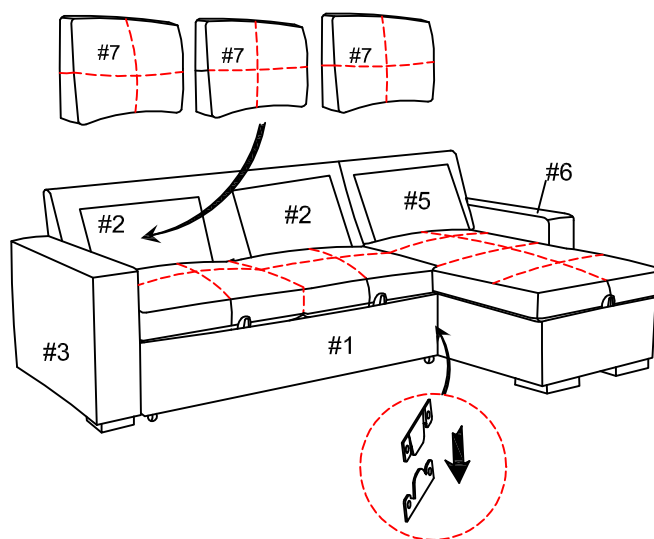
