

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
Level Cabinet


Prior to installing components, it is important to level the cabinet with the floor. Verify that all of the feet are properly adjusted to support the cabinet evenly.





Install Shelves










Affix shelf peg assembly to post at desired position and secure using hex key.

Remove plastic coating from shelves and place onto shelf pegs.






At this point you may install accessories (IR Repeater Kit, Power Conditioner, Etc.) and place components.




Glass Top




Speaker Grill Assembly (Applicable Models Only)




Attach the two brackets (303-370) using the waferhead screws (300-115) to backside of speaker grill. Note the "UP" arrow.




Place grill pads (303-545) flush to corner edges.







Fine Tuning/Tips





Adjust the tops of the doors to be parallel to the top of the cabinet.





Dismount Hinge from Hinge Plate
With one hand holding the door open, pull back on the hinge quick-release lever (B).
