# PRE ASSEMBLY

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.

















#### Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.

#### **Suitable Location**

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.

#### **Sufficient Space**

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.

#### **Avoid Scratches**

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.

#### **Flat Surface**

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

## ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE



FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES BELOW MAY RESULT IN INJURY AND/OR PROPERTY DAMAGE.



Save the instructions and store any supplied tools for later maintenance.

After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

IT IS THE USER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO MAINTAIN THE FURNITURE. THE HARDWARE MAY LOOSEN OVER TIME AND MAY CAUSE THE FURNITURE TO BE WOBBLY AND UNABLE TO SUPPORT ITS INTENDED WEIGHT CAPACITY. THIS MAY LEAD TO COLLAPSE AND MAY CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY.

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



- Prepare 8 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#B) onto the bolt (#A) and then the flat washer (#C) onto the SAME bolt (#A), in that order.
- II. Align the long sides of the 4 Lbrackets (#E) with the pre-drilled holes on the shelf (#2). Insert 4 bolt assemblies through the long sides of the L-brackets (#E) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#D) to lock them with the shelf (#2).
- III. Align the 4 stands (#3) with the short sides of the 4 L-brackets (#E) assembled on the shelf (#2). Insert 4 bolt assemblies through the short sides of the L-brackets (#E) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#D) to lock them with the stands (#3).

Part A x1pc Hardware G x4pcs Hardware A x4pcs Hardware X4pcs

- I. Align the base (#4) with the predrilled holes on the stands (#3).
- II. Prepare 4 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#H) onto the bolt (#G) and then the flat washer (#I) onto the SAME bolt (#G), in that order.
- III. Insert the bolt assemblies through the base (#4) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#J) to lock them with the stands (#3).



### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**



Insert the 4 threaded studs (#F) into the top of the stands (#3). Then insert the 4 spacers (#K) onto the 4 threaded studs (#F).

- I. Carefully place and center the glass top (#1) over the spacers (#K).
- II. Make sure the table is rested on a flat surface and does not feel loose or wobbly. If it does, double check that the bolts/screws are secured and properly tightened.



#### ASSEMBLY COMPLETED

Please ensure the furniture rests on an e and flat surface. If the product wobbles or fee loose, double-check a bolts and/or screws ar properly tightened and secured.
