Wood Furniture Maintenance:

- Always dust, wipe, and clean with the grain of the wood.
- Dust with a soft cloth. Dust will scratch the furniture surface if not removed properly.
- Use the same type of polish consistently as interchanging oil-based and wax-based polishes will cause a build-up and result in a foggy or cloudy appearance.
- If a polished surface becomes foggy, rub it with a cloth dipped in a solution of one tablespoon vinegar to one quart of water. Rub softly with the grain until the surface is completely dry.
- Soap and water are not advisable for wood surfaces. Water can penetrate the finish and raise the grain on wood, causing damage.
- Remember to change dusting cloths frequently as dirty cloths may scratch your furniture's surface

The Enemies of Wood:

- Moisture is wood's worst enemy. Liquid spills should be gently wiped up immediately. Coasters should be used under all beverages.
- Do not allow rubber or vinyl materials to lie on the furniture. Chemicals in rubber may leave a stain. Put a strip of felt or leather under accessories that have rubber or vinyl.
- Heat creates a chemical change in the furniture's finish, which results in a white spot. Use protective pads under hot dishes, appliances, etc.
- Sunlight's ultraviolet rays can damage the finish of furniture. Do not place furniture directly against a heater or radiator and do not place in the path of hot streams of air from central heating. This will cause extreme localized drying of the wood.

High Gloss Resin Table Maintenance:

- Resin tabletops have approximately 1/8" of a resin coat on the top face of the table, which will resist ice, water, wine, liquor, food, cleaning fluids, and warm or hot liquids; however, cups, glasses, etc. containing hot liquids should not be left on the table without a coaster for protection.
- Resin tabletops will scratch just the same as any other glossy surface and basic precautions should be taken.
- For lasting shine, the resin table should be waxed with a car wax that does not contain silicon. Maintaining this wax build-up will result in a high gloss shine.
- When wiping down the table, a soft, clean rag should be used. Do not use a heavy paper.

Granite Top Maintenance:

The surface of the granite on your table has been polished or sealed to create a generally non-porous surface. The stone has many natural characteristics including: veining, hairline cracks, and color variations - which make up the stone's heauty.

To maintain the beauty of your granite:

- Protect surfaces from scratching, staining and etching by:

- * Wiping up spills immediately
- *Avoiding contact with chemicals(particularly acid-based materials)
- Clean with pH neutral products or those especially formulated for use on stone.
- It is not recommended to use a water-based solvent for dark granite as it will remove the polish from the surface. Absorbed into the stone.
- After a period of use, apply a penetrating sealer to prevent contaminants from being


DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS AND HEX NUTS UNTIL THE ENTIRE UNIT IS COMPLETELY ASSEMBLED



Step 1: Attach 2 Table Leg (C) to the corners of the Table Base (B) by inserting Bolt (1), Lock Washer (2), Flat Washer (3) and tighten with Wrench (5). Do not fully tighten.



Step 2: Attach last 2 Table Leg (C) to the corners of the Table Base (B) by inserting Bolt (1), Lock Washer (2), Flat Washer (3) and tighten with Wrench (5) as the picture shown. Do not fully tighten.




Step 3: Turning the assembly base in step 2 to upright position.

Attach the Mounting Plate (D) on the top of 4 Table Leg (C) by inserting Hex Nut (4), Lock Washer (2), Flat Washer (3) and tighten with Wrench (5) as the picture shown.

Fully tighten all Bolts and Hex Nuts in Step 1,2,3 at this time. Do not over tighten.


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Step 4: Place Table Top (A) upside down on a piece of cloth or carpet to prevent finish from scratching.


Attach the Assembly Base in Step 3 to the table slide of the Table Top (A) by using Bolt (1), Lock Washer (2), Flat Washer (3) and fully tighten with Wrench (4) as the picture shown.

Do not over tighten.




Step 5: Turning the Table to upright position . Insert the Shelf Clip (6) into the pre-drill holes inside of the Table Base (B) and put the Shelf (E) on to the Shelf Clip (6).

Unlock the Latch underneath the Table Top (A) pull the Table Top (A) from both ends. Insert Table Leaf (F) to the middle of Table Top (A), close the Table Top (A) by pushing from both ends. Lock the latch underneath the Table Top (A) to prevent from sliding. Assembly of product is now completed.



Step 6: Take the Sliding Door (G) out of the box and press down the pin as the picture (1-1).


Attach the Sliding Door (G) to the Table Base (B) by aligning the door into the top grove and the bottom grove at the same time and then press up the pin as the picture (2-2) & (3-3). Assembly is now completed.







Step 1: Place the Chair ack (A) on the floor. Attach Seat ox w/Seat Cushion () to the Chair ack (A) by inserting the Short olt (2), Lock Washer (), Flat Washer () into the holes at the rear bar of the seat frame. Long olt (1), Lock Washer (), Flat Washer () into the holes at the rear corner block of the Seat ox. Tighten all olts with Wrench (6). Do not fully tighten.




Step 2: Attach the Left / Right Front Leg (C/D) to the Seat ox w/Seat Cushion () by using Flat Washer (), Lock washer () and Hex ut (5), secure by Hex Wrench (6). Do not fully tighten.

Attach the Left/Right Side Stretcher (F/) to Left/Right Front Leg (C/D) and

(F/) to Left/Right Front Leg (C/D) and Chair ack (A). Insert the Front Stretcher () to the middle of Left/Right Front Leg (C/D) by using Pan Head Screw () with Phillip -head screwdriver (ot provided).

<u>Step</u>: Place the Chair to upright position on flat surface and adjust legs until level and does not wobble. Fully tighten all olts and Hex uts with Wrench (6). Assembly of product is completed.



Steve Silver Company Dining Chairs- **Assembly Troubleshooting Guide**

The most important element of correct chair assembly is to tighten the bolts as directed. Prematurely tightening the bolts can lead to numerous issues and will lengthen the assembly time. Listed below are the most common issues in chair assembly and their easy solutions.

PROBLEM: Chair is unlevel.

Cause 1:

Unlevel chairs can occur if the bolts are fully tightened before all bolts are attached. There is a variance in the alignment of this chair to allow the chair to be assembled more easily.

Solution:

Loosen each bolt in the seat box (front legs, back corner blocks and back apron) until they are finger tight. Place the chair upright on the floor. Sit in the chair for about 30 seconds. Carefully turn the chair upside down and tighten each bolt. The chair will now be level.

Cause 2:

Unlevel chairs can occur if one or more of the floor glides are missing from the bottom of the chair leg.

Solution:

PROBLEM: Bolts do not fit properly.

Cause:

This issue can occur when the bolts are tightened fully before all bolts are attached. There is a variance in the alignment of the bolts to allow the chair to be assembled more easily. Tightening the bolts prematurely can cause the holes for the other bolts to become slightly misaligned, causing the remaining bolts not to fit properly.

Solution:

Make sure each bolt in the seat box (front legs, back corner blocks and back apron) is loosened until finger tight. This will allow you to realign the holes, and the bolts will now fit properly.

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
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
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

Attach the Long Stretcher (E) in the middle of 2 Bench Leg (B);(C) by inserting Pan-Head Screw (4) and tighten with phillips-head screwdriver (not provided).

Do not fully tighten.





Step 2: Attach the Side Stretcher (D) to the Bench Leg (B);(C) by inserting Pan-Head Screw (4) and tighten with phillips-head screwdriver (not provided). Do not fully tighten.

Step 3: Attach the last Left Bench Leg(B) and Right Bench Leg (C) to the corner block of the Seat Box w/ Seat Cushion (A) by inserting Hex Nut (1), Lock Washer (2), Flat Washer (3) and tighten with Wrench (5).

Attach the last Long Stretcher (E) in the middle of 2 Bench Leg (B);(C) by inserting Pan-Head Screw (4) and tighten with phillips-head screwdriver (not provided).

Place Bench upright side position on flat surface and adjust Bench legs until level and not wobble. Fully tighten all hex nuts and Screws with Hex Wrench (5) and phillips-head screwdriver (not provided). Assembly product is completed.




Step 1: Place the Server (A) upside down on a piece of cloth or carpet to prevent finish from scratching. Attach Metal Leg (B) to the Server (A) by inserting Hex Bolt (1), Flat Washer (3), Lock Washer (2) and fully tighten with Wrench (4). Do not over tighten.



Step 2: Turn the Server to upright position. (*Note: It is recommended to use two or more people to turn the Server). Place the Server on flat surface and adjust the Leveler under the Metal Legs (B) until level and does not wobble.

- Open the Doors, remove the Handles by unfasten the Handle's Bolts and attach it to the outside of the Doors by using Phillips-head screwdriver (not provided) as the picture shown.
- The Tipping Restraint (5) is stapled at the back of Server (A). Thread Tipping Restraint (5) through the slots of the Server (A) to fasten and lock as the picture shown. Assembly of product is now completed.


