Description

The CSA-PWS40 is a wall-mounted, 40 W, 24 V regulated power pack that provides power for a Crestron® shade.

The CSA-PWS40 provides local power for one Crestron shade motor, such as the CSM-QMT shade motor, via a direct connection to the motor's pigtail. This is useful in situations where an infiNET EX $^{\circ}$ wireless network is employed or where power cannot be supplied over a Cresnet $^{\circ}$ cable.

Installation and Wiring

NOTE: Install and use this product in accordance with appropriate electrical codes and regulations.

Follow these steps to install the CSA-PWS40.

- 1. Connect the flying leads from the CSA-PWS40 to the supplied connectors.
- 2. Connect the CSA-PWS40 to the CSM-QMT shade motor.
- After all connections have been made, plug the CSA-PWS40 into a 120 V power outlet.
