



Factory Equipment Removal Process


1 Using a panel removal tool release the clips and remove the center dash trim.




2 Using a panel removal tool release the clips and remove the dash panel above the glovebox.




3 Using a panel removal tool release the clips on the passenger side vent panel and remove it.




4 Remove the HVAC by pulling towards the back of the vehicle.



5 Remove the panel on the right side of the steering wheel column to reveal a 10mm screw.




6 Extract (4) 10mm screws from the factory radio and remove it.




Factory Equipment Removal Process (continued)

7 Remove the USB/Aux panel by pulling towards the back of the vehicle.




8 Press and release (4) tabs on the passenger side lower dash cover and remove it.



9 Extract (4) T50 Torx screws from the passenger side seat.




10 Tilt the passenger seat towards the back to reveal (2) connectors. Disconnect and remove the seat.




1 Connect the power cable to the Positive (+) battery terminal in the engine compartment and route the cable towards the passenger side as shown below. Note: The negative terminal should remain disconnected unit the installation is completed.




2 Route the power cable thru the rubber grommet on the passenger side the firewall.




3 Place the Subwoofer level remote by the center console compartment and route the cable to the passenger side seat.




4 Open the etched carpet towards the front of the passenger side seat support are and remove the paint to expose bare metal. Attached the **Negative** (-) ground terminal with the provided wafer head screw and lock washer.



5 Connect the power cable to the main harness.




6 Connect the main harness and subwoofer level knob to the amplifier assembly and align it to the seat mounting holes.




7 Route the main harness along the side of the center console to the radio location. **Note: Use the included cable ties to secure the harness.**



9 Mount the Subwoofer level remote using the provided hook and loop adhesive tape on the center console below the HVAC.






10 Return all removed components for their corresponding location and connect the Negative (-) battery terminal.


OEM Head Unit Wiring Diagram




Aftermarket Head Unit Wiring Diagram



OPRODUCTS COVERED:

This Warranty covers Car Audio Products and Related Accessories ("the product"). Products purchased in the Canada are covered only in the Canada. Products purchased in the U.S.A. are covered only in the U.S.A.

OLENGTH OF WARRANTY:

This Warranty is in effect for three years from the date of the first consumer purchase.

•WHO IS COVERED:

This Warranty only covers the original purchaser of the product, who must reside in the United States, Puerto Rico or Canada.

OWHAT IS COVERED:

This Warranty covers defects in materials or workmanship (parts and labor) in the product.
