Drawer (G)







Attach Drawer Front (G1) and Drawer Back (G2) to Drawer Side (G3) with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.

Attach Drawer Side (G4) to unit with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.






STEP 9

Attach Handle with 3/4" Flat Head Screws.


Note: Drawer assembly is not complete until 3/4" Flat Head Screws are used in a later step.




Insert drawer into unit, then adjust drawer front panel left or right and up or down until drawer gaps look proportional.



Pull drawer open slowly, then re-tighten screws from Step 10.


Make sure drawer front panel does not move and lock drawer front panel into position with 3/4" Flat Head Screws.

Note: To remove Drawer (G) in future, push plastic lever on left side up, push plastic lever on right side down and pull open. (See Figures 4 and 5)


