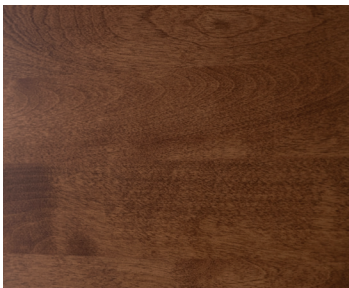

OUR FINISHES

MATTE



Our matte finish is the smoothest one offered at Canadel. It is neutral, timeless, and can match many different styles.

The antique finish is applied subtly, using our unique techniques and tools which help us create the appearance of slightly-aged wood.

DISTRESSED



The Distressed finish is the one that best highlights the wood's natural appearance. Contours are uneven and marks made with our unique techniques and tools mimic the natural wear-and-tear of wood aged over time.

The Rustic finish offers an industrial look. The natural characteristics are highlighted, and finished with our own tools and techniques. In lighter stains, it is possible to see color variations between each wood plank.

The East Side distressed finish is more moderate than the rustic finish. The natural characteristics are highlighted and finished with our own tools and techniques.

Because of the workmanship and natural materials used in each item made by Canadel, variations can occur from one piece to the other. Our warranty does not cover differences between your furniture and floor samples, finish samples, printed illustrations or web illustrations on UDesign. The same applies for fabrics and samples.

Over time Canadel has created its own finish, consisting of a catalysed lacquer, which is applied to all our furniture for enhanced protection.
