Tighten all bolts used.

Cover all Head Cap Bolts with Caps.

Turn unit to its upright position.



STEP 6

Attach RAF Loveseat and LAF Loveseat to Corner Chair with 6 pcs. of clips.

Hold Seat Frames of left unit and right unit together.

Ensure the legs straight and there is no gap.

Squeeze adjoining frames tightly together & hook one of the arms (of the clip) on the backside of the tube.

Spread the clip open by pushing it against and across the tubes so it captures both seat frames. (See Figures 3, 4 and 5)

Note: Do not use a tool to force the clips on






