

WARNING:

- · Keep bed in a flat position when not in use.
- Stav clear of moving parts while in motion.
- Before adjusting, make sure children and pets are clear of moving parts and are not under bed base.
- Do not allow children to operate bed base without adult supervision.
- Always unplug the base from the electrical outlet before servicing any part of the base. To reduce risk of electric shock, unplug the base before cleaning. To safely disconnect, ensure the base is in a flat position with all motors off, and unplug from power source.
- For optimal safety and operation, plug bed base into a surge protector (not included). The bed base should only be plugged directly into a grounded wall outlet or surge protector (strongly recommended). Improper connection of the equipment can result in the risk of electrical shock, electrical fire or faulty operation of this bed base. If the plug does not fit your outlet, contact a qualified Electrician to install a suitable outlet.

PETS AND CHILDREN:


Tampering with or opening the control box, motors, or remote control (with the exception of replacing batteries) will void the warranty.

OPERATING INFORMATION:


- After adjustable base assembly is completed, operate remote control to ensure proper functions before occupying the bed.
- Keep moving parts free of obstruction during adjustable base operation (including sheets, clothing, tubing, wiring, and products using electric power cords).
- Distribute body weight evenly over bed surface during operation.

Do not operate the bed while sitting directly on the head or foot sections of the bed.


Setup the power foundation without the bed frame.





Take out all the accessories from the packaging and put them aside. All electronics and components that need to be installed are located in boxes under the foundation or attached to the frame. Before discarding the packing materials, ensure that all the parts are accounted for.




Remove the red plastic safety lock before unfolding your power foundation.












Prepare The Motion Sensor Hardware.










Connect The Motion Sensor Connectors.

STEP 1: Clip the mounting bracket onto the center adjustable legs as illustrated.




STEP 2: Connect the motion sensor connectors as illustrated. Note there are two connectors, one on each side of the bed.


Uncoil the AC power cords, connect the DC power cords to the power supplies and then connect the power supplies to the AC power sources.



Installation method 1:


(Exclusively for BEDGEAR Mattresses)

Insert the flat mattress retainer bar into the securing strap at the bottom of the BEDGEAR mattress and then snap it into the mattress retainer mounts.




Installation method 2:

Alternatively, install the mattress retainer bar one side after another for non-BEDGEAR mattresses.




Setup the power foundation with the bed frame and slat base.

Take the bed out of the box, put it on the slat base, do not install any legs.




Turn over the bed. Uncoil the DC power cords.




Motion sensor installation


STEP 1: Connect the motion sensor connectors as illustrated.




STEP 2: Use the double sided tape to secure the motion sensor when necessary.



Pull the DC power cords toward the direction of the AC power sources through either the bottom or the side of the bed frame. Pull the two motion sensors to the two sides of the bed frame. Make the bed completely flat with a flipping motion.



Uncoil the AC power cords, connect the DC power cords to the power supplies and then connect the power supplies to the AC power sources.



Installation method 1:



Insert the flat mattress retainer bar into the securing strap at the bottom of the BEDGEAR mattress and then snap it into the mattress retainer mounts.



Remote Control Instructions



SELECT BUTTON



Press these two button to select Head/Foot/Lumbar zone.

ADJUST



This button lifts the Head/Foot/ Lumbar section of the foundation.



This button lowers the Head/Foot/ Lumbar section of the foundation.

MASSAGE FEATURES



Turn on the head massage. Cycle through 3 massage intensities.



Turn on the foot massage. Cycle through 3 massage intensities.

STOP Turn off the head/foot massage.

SETTING PROGRAMMABLE POSITION

One-touch programmable positions.

UNDER BED LIGHTING



Under bed LED lighting on/off.

ONE TOUCH BUTTON



One-touch ANTI-SNORE preset position.



One-touch flat position.



One-touch TV preset position.




One-touch ZERO G preset position. ZERO G adjusts your legs to a higher level than your heart, helping to relieve pressure of the lower back and promote circulation.

Pairing Remote

The original remotes that came in the box are already paired to the foundations. No further action is required. In the event when the remotes are not paired with the foundations, follow the pairing instructions below.

ATTN: THE TWO REMOTES CANNOT BE PAIRED AT THE SAME TIME.

- STEP 1: Make sure the batteries of both remotes are good. Replace them when needed
- STEP 2: Unplug both power cords from the power sources. If 9V backup batteries were installed in the power supplies, remove them.




- STEP 3: Press and hold shows "PAIR".
- STEP 4: Plug the power cord connected to the left side of bed ("L") back into the power source. The LCD screen on the remote ("L") shows "PASS", and you will hear an activation sound in 2 seconds indicating the remote ("L") is paired to the power foundation.
- STEP 5: The operation of pairing remote ("**R**") is the same as remote ("**L**"), as in steps 3 through 4.

Foot Sync Instruction

ATTN: THE TWO REMOTES CANNOT BE USED AT THE SAME TIME AFTER BEING SUCCESSFULLY SYNCHRONIZED.

STEP 1: Make sure both remotes are individualy paired to the foundation. If any of the remotes is not paired with the foundation, please follow the paring instructions.



- STEP 2: Make sure both foundations are at flat position.
- STEP 3: Press and hold ▲ and ▼ on both remotes at the same time for 8 seconds until the LCD screen shows **SYNC** to achieve foot synchronization.

Setting Programmable Position

- STEP 1: Adjust the head and foot to your desired position.
- STEP 2: Press and hold the LED button $\Rightarrow f$ for about 5 seconds until the screen shows **SAVE**, then press programmable buttons **M1** or **M2**, until you hear 2 beep sounds.
- STEP 3: To save a new position, repeat step 1 and 2 and the new position will be saved.

Setting Remote Lock

LOCK

Press and hold n m m and \blacktriangle buttons simultaneously for about 5 seconds until the LCD screen shows **LOCK**.

UNLOCK

Press and hold (n) (m) (m) and \blacktriangle buttons simultaneously for about 5 seconds until the LCD screen **LOCK** disappear.

BATTERY LEVEL



The battery icon in the upper-right conner shows the battery level, replace the batteries when the battery level is low.

BEDGEAR Mobile APP (Optional)

General Information

BEDGEAR Mobile APP is a mobile application to control the BEDGEAR Adjustable Base with mobile devices. The application is available for both iOS and Android based smart devices.

The BEDGEAR Mobile APP uses Bluetooth technology to communicate with your BEDGEAR Adjustable Base. Make sure your mobile device(s) have Bluetooth capability for the APP to work correctly.

Install the BEDGEAR APP

IOS



- Open APP Store on your IOS device
- Tap the Magnify Glass Icon old Q and search with the keyword
- Tap on ^{*}GET and INSTALL to install the APP
- · Wait for the download/installation to be complete

Android




- Open Google Play on your Android device.

Device Pairing

Before you start, switch on Bluetooth on your mobile device. Make sure your BEDGEAR Adjustable Base is correctly connected and is power-on.

The BEDGEAR APP will automatically pair your BEDGEAR Adjustable Base once you start the APP and does not require additional settings.





Legs Installation Guide






Support leg may be needed on some slat/platform bed frames, refer to the leg configuration table for height adjustment.

* Make sure the adjustable legs are properly tight, and the plastic caps have been placed at the bottom of the legs. Incorrect installation might cause the part to fail or damage the floor.


Stabilizer Brackets are optional and not included. They can fix the bed onto the slat base. A phillips screwdriver and socket wrench are required to complete the installation.



Lift the head and foot end of the bed by remote control. Install four stabilizer brackets as shown. Use a phillips screwdriver and socket wrench to tighten the screws and bolts.


Headboard Bracket Installation Guide (Optional)

Headboard brackets are optional and not included. A 1/2" (13 mm) socket and 1/2" (13 mm) wrench are required to complete the installation.



STEP 1


a) Align the slot hole of the headboard bracket to the sleeve into which the leg threads. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN. Too much force may damage the thread.



b) The headboard bracket has 2 adjustable slots to accommodate any frame type. Use the bolts and washers to secure the bracket. Make sure the bolts are tight.

STEP 2

a) To put the T-Bracket and Headboard Bracket together, you will need (2) M8×16 bolts and (2) nuts. Slip the bolts through the holes from T-Bracket to Headboard Bracket with the head of bolt facing outward. Use the 1/2" (13 mm) socket and 1/2" (13mm) wrench to tighten the bolts.



STEP 3

You may now connect your headboard to the attachment plates using the remaining short bolts and nuts to secure it to the brackets. The heads of the bolts will face outward. Use a 1/2" (13mm) socket and 1/2" (13mm) wrench to tighten the bolts.

Audio System

Pairing Instruction

- 1. Once power is supplied, the audio kit begins to search pairing device automatically. It keeps searching until it pairs with other device successfully. It could only pair with one device at a time. If you want to pair with a different device, disconnect the paired device, before connect with the new device.
- 2. The audio kit could be controlled via the paired device.
- 3. Description of device: REMO4.11
- 4. Connection rang: 26 ft.

Frequently Asked Qustions

Description of problem	Possible cause, correction & maintenance		
No sound	The volume is on minimum; Audio System not paired properly; Please contact the store or customer service.		
Audio System cannot be paired	Restart your power base; Do not attempt to pair the device behind a wall; Make sure you're pairing the device within the working distance (26 ft).		
Remote control is locked and cannot be operated	Press and hold ⑰ శ and ▲ buttons simultaneously for about 5 seconds until the LCD screen LOCK disappear.
