### FRAMED

Choose framed custom door panels that contrast with the stainless steel full-length handles and louvered grille (shown). The framed application is an overlay model with framed design features. Panel, grille, and handle options are available.

**Panels:** Custom panels, stainless steel, or white enamel.

**Grille:** Classic louvered grille insert or solid custom panel for 84" (standard), 83", or 88" overall unit height. Dual wide grille for dual installations.

**Handles:** Full-length standard or extended handles.

### OVERLAY

Custom overlay door panels can be combined with unique handle hardware for design flexibility. Shown with the pro handle option to complement Wolf ranges. Customize with panel, grille, and handle options.

**Panels:** Custom panels or stainless steel.

**Grille:** Solid custom panel or pro louvered grille for 84" (standard), 83", or 88" overall unit height. Dual wide grille for dual installations.

**Grille:** Solid custom panel or pro louvered grille for 84" (standard), 83", or 88" overall unit height. Dual wide grille for dual installations.

**Handles:** Custom, tubular, or pro handles.


### Electrical Requirements

The electrical supply should be located within the shaded area shown in the illustration below. A separate circuit servicing only this appliance is required. A ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI) is not recommended and may cause interruption of operation.

Installation must comply with all applicable electrical codes.

### Plumbing Requirements


Locate the water supply line within the shaded area shown in the illustration below. Connect the water supply line to the house supply with an easily accessible shut-off valve. Do not use self-piercing valves. The water supply line must not interfere with the installation of the anti-tip brackets.

A reverse osmosis system can be used provided there is constant water pressure of 35–120 psi (2.4–8.3 bar) supplied to the unit at all times. A copper line is not recommended for this application.

Installation must comply with all applicable plumbing codes.

## Custom Panels

For framed, overlay, and flush inset applications, custom door panels must be provided. Handle hardware must also be provided for overlay and flush inset applications. Refer to Panel Requirements below and the charts on pages 22–27 for custom panel dimensions for your specific design application.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Do not cover a glass door with a solid panel.

Finish all sides of the custom panels. They may be visible when the door is open or through the window of glass door models.


## FRAMED PANELS

The framed application is an overlay model with framed design features. It is not a separate model.

If the custom panel is thinner than 1/4" (6), a filler material must be added to achieve a proper fit. If the panel is thicker than 1/4" (6), rout an edge around the panel or mount the custom panel on a sheet of 1/4" (6) thick material and insert into the channel. Refer to the illustrations below.

Routing, recessing, or optional extended handles may be required for finger clearance. Refer to the full-scale template on page 34.


### PANEL MOUNTING KIT

The Sub-Zero custom panel mounting kit eliminates the need for the backer and spacer panels and is available through an authorized Sub-Zero dealer. For local dealer information, visit the find a showroom section of our website, subzero.com. The kit consists of mounting cleats, screws, and gages used to properly position the cleats. The kit is available for all Classic models except glass door models. Dual installations require two mounting kits.

### OVERLAY PANELS

Overlay panels are typically created by combining a <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" (19) custom panel, a .10" (3) spacer panel, and a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" (6) backer panel. Refer to the illustrations below.

## Custom Panels

### FLUSH INSET PANELS

The flush inset application is an overlay model with flush inset panels. It is not a separate model.


The flush inset design allows custom panels to be installed flush with adjacent cabinets. Similar to overlay, flush inset panels are typically created by combining a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (19) custom panel, a .10" (3) spacer panel, and a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6) backer panel. Refer to the illustrations for overlay panels.

For flush inset panels thicker than  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (19), a 90° door stop may be required to prevent interference with adjacent cabinets. Refer to the full-scale templates at the end of this guide.

When installing two units side by side, refer to page 17 for dual flush inset installations.


### ICE AND WATER DISPENSER

For models BI-42SD and BI-48SD, the refrigerator door panel must include a cutout to accommodate the external dispenser. The bezel will accommodate a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6) thick panel for framed applications and a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (19) thick panel for overlay and flush inset applications. Panels thicker than  $\frac{3}{4}$ " (19) must be routed in the dispenser area to  $1\frac{1}{8}$ " (29) (including backer and spacer panels).




Dispenser dimensions



## Dual Installation

If two units are installed side by side, a dual installation kit may be required. Installations without a custom filler strip require a dual installation kit. If a dual installation kit is not specified, a 2" (51) filler strip is recommended between the units. A custom filler strip is required when installing two French door or side-by-side models. Dual installations without a filler strip can only be accomplished using two 84" (2134) units with opposite hinges. Refer to the illustrations below.












Upper valance—column and tall (side view)






Panel assembly (cross section)





### DUAL INSTALLATION

If two units are installed side by side, a dual installation kit may be required. Installations without a custom filler strip require a dual installation kit. If a dual installation kit is not specified, a 2" (51) filler strip is recommended between the units. Dual installations without a filler strip can only be accomplished using two units with opposite hinges. Refer to the illustrations below.

Locate the electrical supply within the shaded area shown in the illustrations below. A separate circuit servicing only this appliance is required.


**IMPORTANT NOTE:** For 24" models, the electrical outlet must be positioned with the grounding prong to the right of the thinner blades.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** For outdoor models UC-24RO and UC-15I(P)O, a ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI) is required to reduce the risk of electrical shock. A GFCI is not recommended for use with other Undercounter models and may cause interruption of operation.



### Plumbing Requirements

Locate the water supply line within the shaded area shown in the illustrations below. Connect the water supply line to the house supply with an easily accessible shut-off valve between the supply and the unit. Do not use self-piercing valves. A saddle valve kit is available through an authorized Sub-Zero dealer. For local dealer information, visit the find a showroom section of our website, subzero.com.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** A reverse osmosis system can be used provided there is constant water pressure supplied to the unit at all times as indicated in the chart below. A copper line is not recommended for this application.




### ICE MACHINE DRAIN

Ice machine models can be ordered with or without a drain pump. Models without a pump will drain water by gravity. A drain must be installed.

The drain and inlet water tubes must be plumbed before connecting to the ice machine. For the gravity drain, horizontal drain lines must have a 1/4" (6) per 12" (305) fall. An air gap will likely be required between the unit and drain. A stand pipe with a trap below is acceptable for the drain.

### Custom Panel

For overlay Undercounter models, a custom door panel and handle hardware must be provided. Refer to the charts for panel requirements and dimensions.

Finish all sides of the custom panels. They may be visible when the door is open or through the window of glass door models.


#### MODEL UC-24BG

For model UC-24BG, the custom door panel will attach directly to the door frame with screws through a series of pre-drilled holes.

Do not install a solid panel on a glass door unit. A solid door is available as a sales accessory and must be installed if a solid panel is specified. Service may be required to install the door. Contact an authorized Sub-Zero dealer for more information. Overall dimensions are the same for glass and solid door panels.

### DOOR CLEARANCE

Undercounter models can be installed flush with surrounding cabinetry. Depending on the thickness of the custom door panel, it may be necessary to install the unit <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" (6) beyond the front surface of adjacent cabinetry to prevent interference when the door is opened to 145°. Refer to the full-scale template on page 99.




