# **DO** Install the Touch Screen


The Crestron® TS-1542 and TS-1542-C touch screens install over a standard 1-gang (horizontally mounted) electrical box or over a 2-gang U.S., a 1- or 2-gang U.K., or a 1- or 2-gang European electrical box using the included wall mount bracket. The touch screens are also suitable for installation using a VESA mount. The TS-1542-TILT and TS-1542-TILT-C models can be placed on a tabletop.

## Mounting into an Electrical Box


To mount the TS-1542 or TS-1542-C into an electrical box, use the following procedure:

- 1. Use the two included 6-32 x 3/8" screws to attach the 2.7" bracket to the rear of the touch screen, as shown in the illustrations that follow step 4.
- 2. Hold the wall mount bracket in position on the electrical box, and then mark the location on the wall above the electrical box for the top two holes on the bracket.
- 3. Use four appropriate mounting screws to attach the wall mount bracket to the electrical box. Use the two included anchors and the two included 6-32 x 1" Phillips screws to secure the wall mount bracket to the wall above the electrical box.
- 4. Place the TS-1542 or TS-1542-C in position on the wall mount bracket and secure it with the two included 4-40 x 1/4" Torx® screws.


Attaching 2.7" Bracket to Rear of Touch Screen (Exploded View)



### **VESA** Mounting

To install the TS-1542 or TS-1542-C using a VESA mount, use the following procedure (refer to the illustration below):

- 1. Gently snap the included top cover assembly into place on the rear of the touch screen.
- 2. Use the two included 6-32 x 3/8" screws to attach the bottom cover assembly to the rear of the touch screen.
- M4 washers to help secure the M4 screws.

VESA Mounting




3. Use the four included M4 x 8 mm screws to attach the touch screen to the VESA mount. If the holes on the VESA mount are large, use the four included

# DO Connect the Touch Screen

Make connections to the touch screen using Crestron power supplies for Crestron equipment. Power and data connection to the TS-1542 can be provided by a single Power over Ethernet+ (PoE+) connection to the LAN port at the rear of the unit (as supplied by the Crestron CEN-SWPOE-16 PoE switch, sold separately), while power and data connection to the TS-1542-C can be provided by a single Power over DM++ (PoDM++) connection to the LAN port at the rear of the unit (as supplied by the Crestron DM-PSU-ULTRA-MIDSPAN PoDM++ injector, sold separately). Apply power after the Ethernet cable is connected.


Hardware Connection for the TS-1542 and TS-1542-C



To gain access to the ports and to install cables on TS-1542-TILT and TS-1542-TILT-C models, use the following procedure:

- 1. Remove the two screws that hold the tilt assembly in place, and then remove the tilt assembly. (Refer to the "Tilt Assembly Removal" illustration in the next column.)
- 2. Remove the two covers under the tilt assembly. (Refer to the "Tilt Assembly Removal" illustration.)
- 3. Attach the required cables to the unit, routing them through the clamp and the slot of the tilt assembly neck. To provide strain relief, ensure the clamp is secured tightly.
- 4. Reinstall the wire cover by sliding it over the ring on the cover plate and snapping it into place. (Refer to the "Wire Cover Reinstallation" illustration in the next column.)
- 5. Reinstall the cover plate by sliding it into place at an angle, and then pressing it toward the touch screen to lock it in. (Refer to the "Cover Plate Reinstallation" illustration in the next column.)
- 6. Reinstall the tilt assembly using the two screws removed in step 1.





## DO Adjust the Tilt (Tilt Models Only)

To adjust the screen angle of a TS-1542-TILT or TS-1542-TILT-C touch screen, perform the following steps:

1. Grip the touch screen by the bottom corners.

2. Firmly push or pull the touch screen; it glides in its base in the direction that force is applied.

NOTE: The minimum tilt angle is 23° from vertical. The maximum tilt angle is 45° from vertical.

# **DO** Access the Setup Screens

The setup screens enable basic configuration prior to regular operation of the TS-1542 or TS-1542-C. To display the main setup screen, touch the screen while applying power to the unit.

NOTE: If no project has been loaded or if an invalid project has been loaded, the touch screen defaults to the main setup screen.

During regular operation of the TS-1542 or TS-1542-C, there are two ways to access the setup screens:

- Place a button on the project main page and assign the reserved join number (17242) that accesses the setup screens.
- Touch the screen with five fingers simultaneously for more than 15 seconds.

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


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Wire Cover Reinstallation
