TRADITIONS COLLECTION FAUX SHAGREEN



The Faux Shagreen finish from our Traditions Collection is a resin-based material and is meant for indoor use only. This material is created by pouring a liquid resin mixture into a mold to recreate the look and feel of real Stingray skin. This process produces an unavoidable variance in color and texture. The mold used creates panels which are then adhered to each piece of furniture resulting in the characteristic seaming. Because this is done by hand, varying degrees of seam visibility are to be expected.

Protect your Faux Shagreen furniture by keeping it out of direct sunlight. Use coasters or trivets to protect the surface from direct heat and liquids. Use felt pads if placing objects directly onto Faux Shagreen to avoid scratching. Do not use heavy force when placing objects directly onto Faux Shagreen – this will help avoid unnecessary cracking.

Care & Maintenance:

Light cleaning should be performed regularly with a damp, clean cloth. Follow by drying with a soft, dry cloth. If a spill occurs, do not let liquid stand for prolonged periods of time. This will help to avoid warping or staining of the material.

Dirt Removal

If debris lingers in the grain of the faux shagreen, dip a clean toothbrush into water and brush the dirt out. Follow by drying with a soft, dry cloth.

Stain Treatment

It is important to treat stains as soon as possible. Only use non-abrasive cleaners as common household cleaners have harsh acids or alkalis that could damage the shagreen surface. Before using any cleaning agent, be sure to test on a less visible area. Never spray cleanser directly onto surface.
