OPTION: INSTALLING GEAR FORWARD

Rack rails may also be installed with the flange forward in applications the door is not desired and additional cabinet depth is needed.

A. Place the 1/2" Button Head Screw (300-485) in the holes of rack mount rail and hinge bracket and loosely screw to Flat-nut (300-560).

 \triangle Note: Rackmount brackets that have a triangle must locate at the top.

- B. Slide Rack Mount Rail into position with the Flat Nuts sliding into the channel as shown. After bracket is in position tighten all screws with hex key.
- C. Snap door onto hinge bases align top and bottom gap and tighten.

For 15 and 21U rails:

D. Install header panel at the top same location of rack mount.





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OPTION: INSTALLING GEAR FORWARD

Rack rails may also be installed with the flange forward in applications the door is not desired and additional cabinet depth is needed.

A For Installing in Synergy Cabinets:

Place the 1/2" Button Head Screw (300-485) in the holes of each bracket and attach loosely with Flat Nut. Note: For assembled cabinets use the Drop-In Nut in place of the Flat Nut. **For Installing in Chameleon Cabinets:**

Use the Drop-In Nuts (300-565) and the shorter 3/8" Button Head Screws (300-518).

- **B** Insert Flat Nuts or Drop-In Nuts into the channels (Use the Front Side Channel for Chameleon). Secure screws with Hex Key.
- C Use standard 10-32 mounting screws to mount equipment on rack rails.
- **D** For 15U & 21U Rails, attach header panel at the top of the rack rail.



Installing Gear Forward

For Small Segment Use Behind Door Install brackets away from door hinges.

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Connect Posts to Bottom Shelf

WARNING: Tighten by screwing the leveler foot NOT the post.





WARNING: If you are installing an optional door or drawer refer to specific instructions before proceeding.



3 Adjust Shelf Pegs & Add Shelves

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Adjusting Shelves

Insert peg down the post channel and position the peg through the Spacer and tighten. You may also consider using books or CD's for shelf spacing.



B. Placing Shelves

Place shelves from the bottom up. Angle the shelf in between the front post and set on top of shelf pegs and heavy duty brackets.

C. Fine Tuning

Use the bubble level to precisely adjust the shelves. Be sure to level both side to side as well as front to back. Use the hex key to tighten each peg.













Secure thumb nuts to finish panel installation.

C. Install Top

Insert the four connector bolts and tighten shelf down.
