### IMPORTANT NOTE

Take all the fittings out of the plastic bag and separate them into groups. Ensure you have enough space to lay out all the parts before assembly. To prevent damage to the parts, we recommend that you assemble the unit on a soft, level surface.

Assembly Instructions

### STEP 1

Detach the transformers (D) from the back rail of the mech under the seat (B). (See Figure 1.)



#### **STEP 2**

Attach the Backs (A) to the Seat (B). Ensure the latches fit well. (See Figure 2.) Zip up the seat cushion and back cushions. Slide the metal inserts on the chair's wings(C) into the metal sleeves on the side of the chair back. Slide the wings(C) down until they are completely set on the backs metal sleeves.





## **Assembly Instructions**

#### STEP 3

Flip up the back flaps, and remove the cables from the Backs (A). Plug all the connecters.(See Figure 3.)



#### STEP 4

Fit the transformers(D) to power port in sofa. Plug the transformers(D) into a nearby outlet, still make sure it is clear of the metal base.(See Figure 4.)



#### STEP 5

Fasten the back flaps to the bottom of the furniture. (See Figure 5.)

# **Disassembly Instructions**

Unzip the seat cushion and back cushions, to remove the back from the base. Pull out the black tab by hand or use a screwdriver pressing outward on black tab, then lift the back from the base of the chair to release.
