#### **PREVENTION**

### **VACUUM FREQUENTLY**

The best way to reduce dirt accumulation and prolong the life of your carpet is t dust, is in the form of hard particles. When left in the carpet, these gritty, sharp particles. How frequently should you vacuum? That depends on the amount carpet is exposed. More use means more frequent vacuuming.
