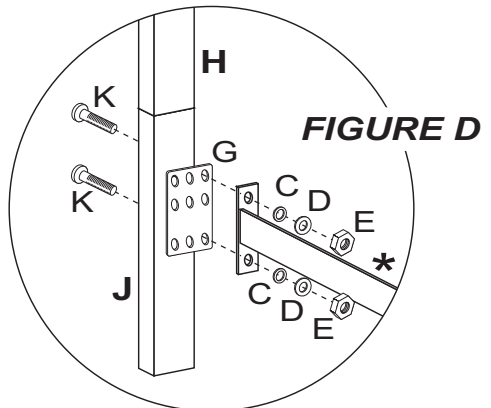
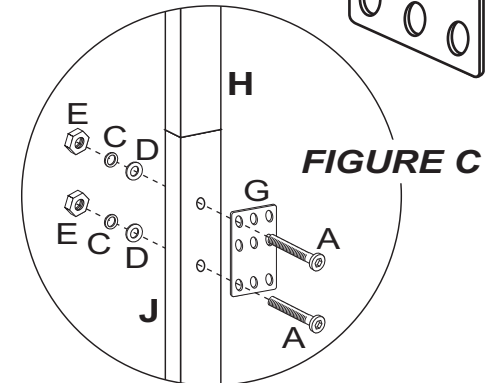
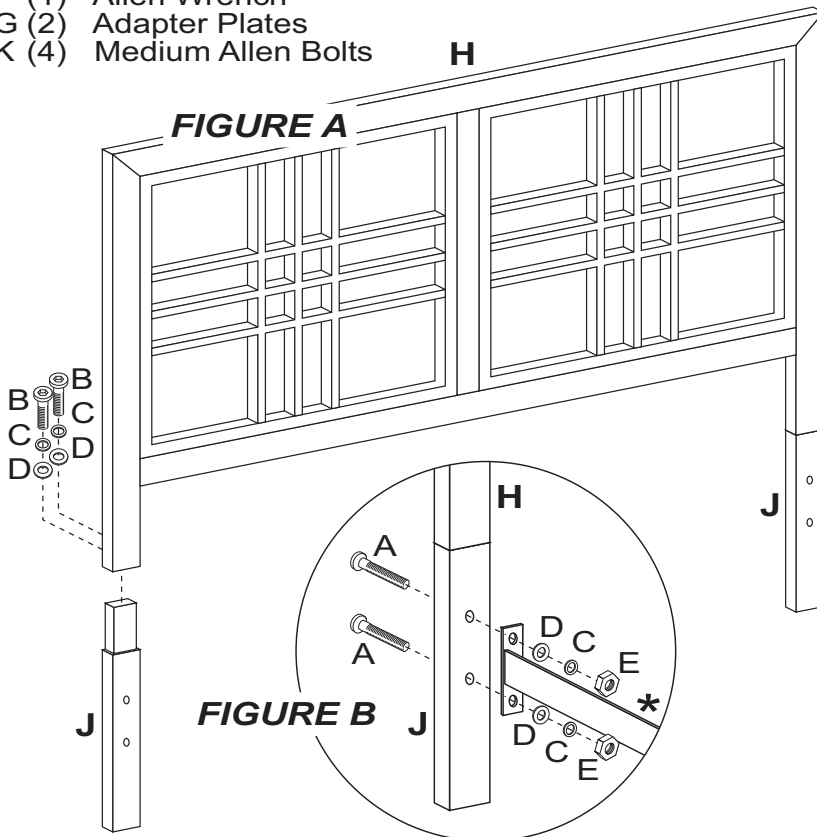
- A (4) Long Allen Bolts

STEP 1 ~ Headboard Assembly

Begin assembly by attaching each Leg Extension (J) to the bottom of each post on the Headboard Panel (H) by firmly sliding into place. Make sure the holes are properly aligned and insert 2 Short Allen Bolts (B), 2 Spring Washers (C) & 2 Flat Washers (D) to secure each in place. Tighten all bolts using the Allen Wrench (F) that has been provided. See Figure A.

STEP 2 ~ Queen Size Bed Frame Assembly

Next, attach the bed frame (*Not Included) to each Leg Extension (J) using 2 Long Allen Bolts (A) from the backside, 2 Flat Washers (D), 2 Spring Washers (C), & 2 Hex Nuts (E) per each side. Tighten all bolts. See Figure B. The assembly of your new bed is now complete.

STEP 3 ~ Full Size Bed Frame Assembly

Attach the Adapter Plate (G) to the Leg Extension (J) using 2 Long Allen Bolts (A), 2 Flat Washers (D), 2 Spring Washers (C) & 2 Hex Nuts (E) per each side. Tighten all bolts.

STEP 4 ~ Full Size Bed Frame Assembly

Finally, attach the bed frame (*Not Included) to the Adapter Plate (G) using 2 Medium Allen Bolts (K), 2 Flat Washers (D), 2 Spring Washers (C) & 2 Hex Nuts (E) per each side. Tighten all bolts. The assembly is now complete.

CARE & MAINTENANCE: The touch of a soft cloth is all the maintenance the finish will ever need. Please do not use harsh or abrasive cleaners for polishing, as they may cause damage to the finish. Periodic checks are recommended to make sure that all bolts, screws and nuts are securely tightened.
