


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

We recommend that two adults work together to assemble this table.

• We suggest that you use a clean flat work area to protect your Cue Rack while assembling.


Step 1: Frame Assembly

- Attach the Shelves to the first Side Panel by inserting the dowels into the predrilled holes of one Side Panel.
- Once the Shelves are firmly attached to one Side Panel, firmly attach the second Side Panel by lining up the predrilled holes with the dowels on the Shelves



Step 2: Frame to Bottom Panel Attachment


- Attach Bottom Panel to Side Panels by inserting the dowels on the Side Panels into the predrilled holes on the Bottom Panel.
- Then secure the Bottom Panel to the Side Panels by using two 1½" Screws in the bottom of the Bottom Panel and two 1½" Screws in the back of the Side Panels.

Step 3: Top Crown Attachment

- Attach Top Crown to Side Panels by inserting the dowels on the Side Panels into the predrilled holes on the Top Crown.
- Then secure the Top Crown to the Side Panels by using Four 1½" Screws in the back of the Top Crown
- Insert the Peg in to the Top Crown.



Step 4: Hanging your Cue Rack

- The Mounting Brackets pre-attached to the back of the Cue Rack are located to facilitate stud mounting, which is recommended.
- For stud mounting, locate the stud center and securely attach the mounting brackets using two 1½" Screws for each Mounting Bracket. For stud mounting, use the middle two holes on the Mounting Bracket.
- If you are unable to mount the Cue Rack using the studs, you must use two Drywall Anchors and two 1½" Screws for each Mounting Bracket. For Drywall Anchor mounting, use the outside two holes on the Mounting Bracket.
- Hang the Cue Rack on the wall as shown. Make sure the Cue Rack is secure.
