

## 3. Safety First

Read manual thoroughly before starting installation of this kit. Verify you have all parts listed and that you clearly understand this installation procedure. Contact Kleinn technical support for any questions.

Installation of this kit requires **moderate mechanical aptitude**; seek professional help if you're not competent using hand tools in tight uncomfortable spaces, and around possibly rusted and sharp vehicle parts.

Before starting, obtain proper tools required to perform installation correctly, adequate lighting, eye protection, hearing protection for operating train horns, and hand protection to guard against sharp edges and metal burrs, which may be present on kit parts and vehicle parts.

Throughout this manual the following words may be used; be aware of their meaning and application.

CAUTION: means damage could occur to vehicle, or kit parts during, or after installation

WARNING: means injury could occur to you or others, including damage to vehicle, or kit parts

DANGER: means serious injury or death could occur to you or others during installation






Figure B - Location Under JKU (Evaporative Canister attachment bolts shown circled)

#### 5.2. Approximate Installation Time

JL-JK-OBA is a multi-faceted product consisting of multiple mechanical, electrical, and pneumatic components.

For a typical home mechanic, auto enthusiast, or technician installing a Kleinn Bolt-On kit for first time, a professional installation job with setup and testing of final product, is estimated to take:

#### • 3-5 Hours

#### 5.3. \*\*\*Quick Install Outline

For person(s) with experience installing Kleinn bolt-on kits, JL-JK-OBA can be installed in an order similar to below:

- 1. Route Wiring, install Relay.
- 2. Bench Assemble Air Tank with Fittings.
- 3. Bench Assemble Air Compressor(s) to Skid Plate/Compressor Bracket (JK-101).
- 4. Install Air Tank Brackets (JK-201, JK-202, JK-203, JL-203, JL-204)
- 5. Install Air Tank to Air Tank Bracket.
- 6. Install Compressor Bracket (JK-101) to Air Tank Bracket (JK-201)
- 7. Connect Air Tank to Air Compressor(s).
- 8. Install Quick Connect Coupler and route Air Tubing
- 9. Test System and adjust, as needed

**CAUTION:** Follow all recommended safety precautions for working on vehicle's electrical system; consult vehicle owner's manual for further instruction.

#### 8.1. Relay and Fuse Diagram for Air Compressor and Air Tank Pressure Switch




Figure 1 - Suggested Ignition Relay Diagram for JL-JK-OBA; Air Horn Also Shown

8.2. Suggested Wire Routing for Air Compressor and Air Tank Pressure Switch





Figure 2 - Suggested Wire Routing for Air Compressor and Pressure Switch (JLU Shown)

- 8.3. Disconnect Vehicle Battery(s)
- 8.3.1. Use special care if vehicle is equipped with Auxiliary Auto Stop Battery. Consult Owner's Manual.
- 8.4. Connect Wiring to Relay(s) and Fuse(s), then Attach to Vehicle
- 8.4.1. Find a suitable location for supplied relay(s) and fuse(s). Shown below is an example location under hood next to battery and near grounding block. Use supplied self-tapping screws, as necessary.

#### 8.5. Route Wiring

- 8.5.1. Route wiring throughout vehicle, per Figure 2 above; however, installer may route as desired.
- 8.5.2. Insert all wiring into included wire loom and ensure loom is away from all sharp edges, hot vehicle parts (i.e., exhaust, engine, radiator), and fasten securely to vehicle using zip ties, or equivalent.

**NOTE:** Do not cut wires to length until 100% sure of length required for final connections.

8.5.3. Install supplied fuse holder on end of power wire by cutting the loop in fuse holder and connecting supplied Ring terminal to one end and Butt connector to other.

**CAUTION:** Do not install 30-amp fuse until all electrical connections are final.

#### 8.5.4. NOTE: FOR VEHICLES WITH FACTORY UPFITTER SWITCHES:

If your vehicle is equipped with factory upfitter (i.e., auxiliary) switches, you may elect to use them for your Kleinn Air Compressor kit; consult Owner's Manual, or dealership for further instructions on what wire terminals to use and programming required.

Shown below is example of Upfitter switches and programming on a JLU Rubicon.


## 9. Bench Assembly Steps

Complete following steps off vehicle to facilitate final installation.

NOTE: ALL HARDWARE WILL BE SPECIFIED IN INSTRUCTIONS USING ITEM NO.'S FOUND IN PARTS LIST. <u>See Parts List.</u> Assemble ALL fasteners clean and dry using proper socket and box-end wrench. (Not including Air fittings)

#### 9.1. Air Tank Fittings

- 9.1.1. Apply two small drops of Kleinn Air Horn Juice to each male pipe thread.
- 9.1.2. Attach air fittings to tank, per below illustration, Click Here to View Fittings List



9.1.3. Hand-tighten each fitting, then further tighten each 1/4-1/2 turn using proper sized box-end wrench; adjust as necessary to match fitting orientation shown in above figure.

- 9.2. Attach Compressor(s) onto Skid Plate Bracket (JK-101)
- 9.2.1. Using <a href="hardware">hardware</a> #9, #15, & #21 mount Compressor(s) to JK-101 with head(s) of Compressor(s) facing outwards, as shown in Figure 3 below.
- 9.2.2. Ensure Compressor is oriented properly, with output "leader" hose facing inward, as shown below.



Figure 3 - Compressor Mounted onto JK-101 \*\*JK6450 Upgrade Shown




Figure 4 - Compressor Fasteners Orientation (Stack-Up)

- 9.2.3. Tighten all fasteners firmly, or if accurate Torque Wrench is available to 28-32 in-lbs.
- 9.2.4. Install Air Compressor filter(s) to each Compressor, or if preferred to mount filters remotely, attach threaded barb to front of compressor inlet.
- 9.2.5. To mount Air Compressor filter(s) remotely, follow instructions included in Air Compressor box.

- 9.3. Attach Air Tank Straps (JK-202) to Air Tank Bracket (JK-201) and Form Straps




Figure 5 - Rubber Trim Attached to JK-201 (Bracket shown on bench)

- 9.3.1. Attach <u>hardware</u> #24 to JK-201 tank supports, as shown in Figure 5 below.

NOTE: Use a short section of tape to secure rubber if it falls off during installation process.

9.3.3. Bend each JK-202 around tank, so they end up shaped round like tank, as shown in Figure 7 below.

- 9.3.4. Remove Air Tank from Tank Bracket, but leave Air Tank Straps attached with a single bolt each.




Figure 8 - JK-202 Air Tank Strap with Rubber Trim

- 9.3.5. Attach hardware #25 to both JK-202, as shown in Figure 8 below.

## 10. On-Vehicle Mechanical Assembly Steps

Complete following steps on vehicle.

Raise vehicle off ground using appropriate vehicle lift, ramps, or jack stands.

**DANGER**: Installation requires being underneath vehicle and applying forces to vehicle chassis. Follow all recommended safety precautions for raising vehicle; consult vehicle owner's manual.

## 10.1. JK ONLY - Air Tank Bracket (JK-201) to Frame Installation

- 10.1.1. Locate factory charcoal canister in rear of vehicle, directly in front of rear coil springs on driver side.





Figure 9 - JK-201 to Evap Canister Install

- 10.1.2. Remove two (2) M8 bolts that hold front side of evaporative canister, as shown in Figure 9 below; do not discard bolts, as they will be used in later step.
  - Canister will slightly hang downwards and a gap will be visible at crossmember




Figure 10 - JK-201 to JKU Mounting Points for Hardware

10.1.3. Insert JK-201 Tank Bracket in between frame crossmember and evaporative canister, as shown in Figure 10 below.

- 10.1.4. Re-install two (2) M8 bolts back into evaporative canister through JK-201 Tank Bracket at location "A", as shown in Figure 10. Hand tighten.
- 10.1.5. Install <a href="https://hardware.nc.">hardware</a> #4, #14 (2), #20 and #10 into front hole of JK-201 going through crossmember at location "B", as shown in <a href="https://example.nc.">Figure 10</a>. Ensure bolt is inserted from bottom with nut above crossmember; hand tighten.

- 10.1.7. Install JK-203 Frame Strap over front cross member and align with JK-201, as shown in Figure 7 below; install <a href="https://mail.org/hardware">hardware</a> #3, #14, #20 and #10 to point "D", as shown in <a href="figure 10">Figure 10</a>. Use #2, #13, and #19 and attach to point "E". Hand tighten.
- 10.1.8. With all fasteners hand tight, make any necessary final adjustment to position of JK201 Tank Bracket then final tighten all fasteners, using below method.




Figure 11 - JK-201 & JK-203 Mounting Strap Install over Crossmember

- 10.1.9. Firmly tighten all fasteners in following order; reference <u>Figure 10</u>:
  - 1. Tighten hardware "E" to 11-13 ft-lbs
  - 2. Tighten hardware "D" to 18-21 ft-lbs
  - 3. Tighten QTY (2) M8 bolts "A" connecting Evaporative Canister to 15-20 ft-lbs
  - 4. Tighten hardware "B" to 18-21 ft-lbs
  - 5. Tighten hardware "C" to 18-21 ft-lbs

10.2. JL ONLY - Adapter Bracket (JL-204) to Frame Installation

10.2.1. Locate two (2) metric M12 X 1.5 threaded holes on rear crossmember, in front of axle, as shown below.

10.2.2. Using <a href="hardware">hardware</a> #8, #17, & #23, install JL-204, as shown in Figure 13 below. Hand tighten only.

#### 10.3. JL ONLY - Air Tank Bracket (JK-201) to Frame Installation

10.3.1. Remove long ground strap nut on middle crossmember, as shown circled in Figure 14 below. Do NOT discard this nut and use care when removing it to prevent stripping threads, or breaking stud.




Figure 15 - JK-201 to JLU Mounting Points for Hardware




Figure 16 - JK-201 & JL-204 Hardware Attached




Figure 17 - JK-201 & JL-204 Section View with Hardware Stack Up

10.3.2. Install JK-201 on top of JL-204 and align holes "A", as shown circled in <u>Figure 15</u>, Figure 16, and Figure 17 below.




Figure 19 - JK-201 Mounting Points

10.3.3. With JK-201 over Ground Strap Stud at point "B", as shown in <u>Figure 15</u> above and Figure 18 below, reinstall OE nut removed using <u>hardware</u> #12 over bracket, as shown in Figure 19. Hand tighten.

- 10.3.4. Insert three (3) #6 facing downwards through JK-201 and JL-204 at holes "A", as shown in Figure 15.
- 10.3.5. Secure JK-201 & JL-204 with <a href="hardware">hardware</a> #10, #14, & #20, as shown in Figure 16. Hand tighten fasteners.
- 10.3.6. Install <u>hardware</u> #7, #16, & #22 through hole "C", as shown in <u>Figure 15</u> and below; this hole intersects a tapped hole in middle crossmember. Hand tighten.

- 10.3.7. Insert JL-203 Mounting Strap over JK-201 and middle crossmember; it is easiest to slide Strap over crossmember near driveshaft, then position it over correct mounting holes. Reference Figure 11 above.
- 10.3.8. Attach JL-203 strap over crossmember to hole "D", as shown in <u>Figure 15</u> and Figure 19 above using <u>hardware</u> #6, #14, #20, and #10; hand tighten.

**NOTE:** If Air Tank interferes/contacts square neck bolt #6, then reverse bolt so nut is above bracket (i.e., opposite of figure 15 shown)

- 10.3.9. Attach final JL-203 Mounting Strap bolt to hole "E", as shown in <u>Figure 15</u> and Figure 19 above using <u>hardware</u> #2, #13, and #19.
- 10.3.10. Firmly tighten all fasteners in following order; reference Figure 15:
  - 6. Tighten hardware "E" to 11-13 ft-lbs
  - 7. Tighten hardware "D" to 18-21 ft-lbs
  - 8. Tighten QTY (2) M12 bolts connecting JL-204 to rear crossmember to 25-30 ft-lbs
  - 9. Tighten QTY (3) square neck bolts "A" to 18-21 ft-lbs
  - 10. Tighten ground strap nut "B" to 75-88 in-lbs
  - 11. Tighten hardware "C" to 30-36 in-lbs

#### 10.4. Air Tank to Tank Bracket Installation




Figure 20 - Air Tank Mounted to JK-201

- 10.4.1. Pull Air Tank Straps away as necessary and lift Air tank into position, with drain facing downwards and towards rear of vehicle, as shown in Figure 20 below.
- 10.4.2. Position Air tank so it is centered within JK-202 straps; adjust as necessary to ensure clearance between drain port and rear Tank Strap of at least 1/8", as shown in Figure 20 below.
- 10.4.3. While holding Air Tank in place, use remaining <u>hardware</u> #1 (2), #11 (2) & #18 (2), to secure Air Tank to Tank Bracket. Final tighten 1/4"-20 fasteners, as shown circled in Figure 20 below to 37-43 <u>in-lbs</u>.

#### 10.5. Skid Plate and Compressor Installation (JK-101)

- 10.5.1. Attach JK-101 (<u>Compressor Assembly</u>) to Tank Bracket and install <u>hardware</u> #2, #13, and #17, as shown in Figure 21 below. Tighten all fasteners to 11-13 ft-lbs.
  - **NOTE**: Air tank Drain hole on JK-101 will be towards the rear of the vehicle and directly below drain valve; loosen and adjust Air Tank position if necessary to re-align position.

#### 10.6. Connect Air Compressor Leader Hose to Air Tank

- 10.6.1. Apply two small drops of <u>Kleinn Air Horn Juice</u> to male pipe thread on Compressor outlet "leader" hose and connect to #8 fitting shown above. Firmly tighten.
- 10.6.2. Connect remote air filter to Compressor if you elected to route remote filters.

#### 10.7. Connect Remote Quick Connect Kit to Vehicle

- 10.7.1. Route and attach Quick Connect Coupler Kit to vehicle, as desired using attachment bracket and self-drilling fasteners, supplied in Coupler package
- 10.7.2. Use supplied 1/4" tubing and attach to port shown above

Some optional locations include under hood, near grill, behind bumper, in bed rail, etc.

#### 11. Initial Testing of Kit

#### 11.1. Reconnect Vehicle Battery(s)

**CAUTION:** Before connecting vehicle battery(s), verify all wiring is properly connected and no shorts exists. Use of Multi-Meter, or Test Light is recommended to check continuity of all connections.

#### 11.2. Test Air Compressor

- 11.2.1. Turn vehicle ignition to on position and allow compressor to fill Air Tank. Initial fill may take approximately 1.5-3 minutes; Air Compressor should shut off automatically once full pressure is achieved.
- 11.2.2. If compressor runs excessively (i.e., 5 minutes or more), disconnect electrical power to Air Compressor and listen for air leaks in system. Repair any problems and retest; contact Kleinn technical support if problem persists.
- 11.2.3. Inspect all air line connections (i.e., Air Tank fittings, Quick Connect fittings, Air Horn fittings, etc.) for leaks by using a soap and water solution sprayed directly onto fittings
- 11.2.4. System must be pressurized or at least Air Compressor running
- 11.2.5. If an air leak is found:
- 11.2.6. Safely release air pressure from system (i.e., slowly open drain valve)
- 11.2.7. Disassemble leaky connection, re-seal and reinstall fittings as needed

#### 11.3. Test Quick Connect Coupler

- 11.3.1. Allow Air Compressor to refill tank, if needed
- 11.3.2. Attach supplied INF-1 inflator kit to Quick Connect Coupler and verify adequate air pressure is available
- 11.3.3. Test fill tires on vehicle, bicycle, etc.
- 11.3.4. Use Air Blow Gun
- 11.3.5. Use Air Impact Gun

## 12. General Operation of Kit

#### 12.1. Compressor Operation

**WARNING:** Never operate Air Compressor above its MAXIMUM PRESSURE RATING (see label on body). Operation exceeding maximum pressure will damage Air Compressor and may result in Dangerous Air System failure.

- 12.1.1. Air compressor is equipped with an automatic thermal overload protection circuit, designed to protect air compressor from overheating and causing permanent damage.
- 12.1.2. Automatic thermal overload protector will automatically reset after 30 minutes.
- 12.1.3. To prevent discharge of vehicle's battery and for best performance, keep vehicle's engine running while using air compressor for any prolonged use (i.e., filling tires, using air tools, etc.).

#### 13. Routine Maintenance

Perform following steps at least once during recommended intervals.

- 13.1. Yearly, or every 12000 miles verify all mounting fasteners are properly torqued; applying witness marks across fasteners and mounting parts is good practice to quickly ensure fasteners have not moved.
- 13.2. Yearly, or every 12000 miles remove all road grime and mud from mounting brackets and kit parts using clean water from a garden hose; pay special attention to corners where dirt may collect. Touch up all paint chips using automotive grade enamel in either spray, or brush form.
- NOTE: High-pressure washers may damage part finishes and *must* be used with care. Do this more frequently if traveling regularly offroad, or in winter climates where road salts are used.

- release air pressure causing injury to nearby people.
- 13.5. Yearly, or every 12000 miles clean, or replace air compressor air filter element. Replacement frequency depends on operating frequency and conditions of operating environment (i.e., daily use of air compressor in dusty, or wet environment requires more frequent filter change). Order replacement filters at Kleinn.com.

NOTE: Never lubricate or add any liquids to the included oil-less air compressor

- 13.3. Yearly, or every 12000 miles check electrical and air fitting connections and wires for abrasion, corrosion, or other damage. Replace damaged components.
- NOTE: if system runs continuously or turns on unexpectedly, leaks or intermittent electrical connection may be present.
- 13.4. Monthly, or every 10 hours of compressor run time, drain moisture from air tank using drain valve installed at bottom of tank.

**WARNING:** Failure to regularly drain air tank may result in corrosion inside tank and possible failure in tank or air lines, which can suddenly
