PREVENTION

Keep the dirt/soil out. Use walk-off mats at entrances and other areas to onto the carpet. Clean mats frequently. Keep your sidewalks and entran

VACUUM FREQUENTLY

The best way to reduce dirt accumulation and prolong the life of your ca dust, is in the form of hard particles. When left in the carpet, these gritty sandpaper. How frequently should you vacuum? That depends on the a carpet is exposed. More use means more frequent vacuuming. Shaw rec “brush/beater bar” to agitate the pile and mechanically loosen soil parti with longer yarns which might tend to wrap around a rotating brush. Fo Also, be aware that some vacuums have overly aggressive action which inexpensive, less efficient vacuum can remove surface dirt but will not e the pile.
