# Playable file Requirement

## Music file requirement

MP3/WMA file compatibility with this unit is limited as follows.

- Sampling frequency: within 32 to 48 kHz (MP3), within 32 to 48 kHz (WMA)
- Bit rate: within 32 to 320 kbps (MP3), 40 to 192 kbps (WMA)
- Maximum files : 2,000
- Maximum folders : 200
- File extensions: ".mp3"/ ".wma"
- Certain MP3/WMA files may not be played depending on the type or format of the file.

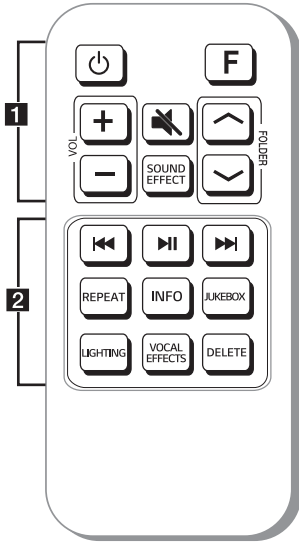
## Compatible USB Devices

- MP3 Player: Flash type MP3 player.
- USB Flash Drive: Devices that support USB2.0 or USB1.1.
- The USB function of this unit does not support all USB devices.

## USB device requirement

- Devices which require additional program installation when you have connected it to a computer, are not supported.
- Do not extract the USB device while in operation.
- For a large capacity USB, it may take longer than a few minute to be searched.
- To prevent data loss, back up all data.
- If you use a USB extension cable or USB hub, the USB device is not recognized.
- Using NTFS file system is not supported. (Only FAT (16/ 32) file system is supported.)
- This unit recognizes up to 2,000 files.
- External HDD, Card readers, Locked devices, or hard type USB devices are not supported.
- USB port of the unit cannot be connected to PC. The unit cannot be used as a storage device.
- Some USB may not work with this unit.

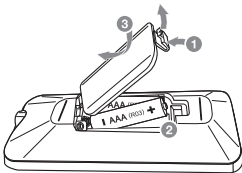

## Replacement of battery



Remove the battery cover on the rear of the remote control, and insert the battery with + and - matched correctly.

**⏮/⏭** (Skip/Search):

- Skips backward or forward.
- Searches for a section within a file.

**⏮** (Play/Pause): Starts or pauses playback.

**REPEAT**: Listens to your files repeatedly or randomly.

**INFO**:

- Sees information about your music. An MP3 file often come with ID3 tag. The tag gives the Title, Artist, Album or Time information.
- Sees **Bluetooth** device name of the unit in BT READY.
- Sees the name of connected all **Bluetooth** device in **Bluetooth** mode.
- In status of WIRELESS PARTY LINK connection, device name of SLAVE (Secondary) unit appears in the MASTER (Primary) unit and device name of MASTER (Primary) unit appears in the SLAVE (Secondary) unit.

**JUKEBOX**:

- Selects JUKE BOX mode. (Page 24)
- Makes JUKE BOX list.

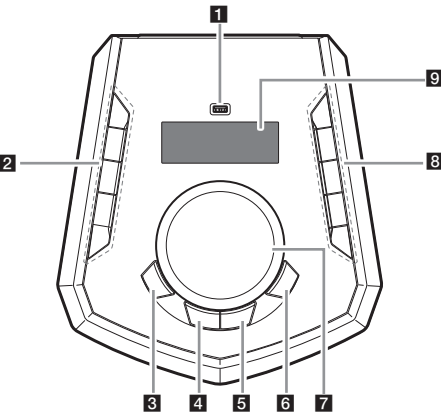
**LIGHTING**: Selects the lighting effects.

**VOCAL EFFECTS**: Selects various voice filters (vocal effects) mode.

**DELETE**:

- Deletes MP3/WMA files. (Page 17)
- Deletes a song on the JUKE BOX list.

You can play sound files by connecting the USB device.

**2** (Standby)  
Turns the power on or off.  
**#/b KEY CHANGER**  
Changes the key to suit your vocal range.

**VOICE CANCELLER**  
You can reduce the vocal tones during music playback from various input sources.

**ECHO/DEMO**  
- Selects ECHO mode.  
- In power off status, if you press **ECHO/DEMO**, shows DEMO mode.

**3** **LIGHTING**  
Selects the lighting effects.

**4** **MIC (Microphone) VOL. (Volume)**  
Select to adjust microphone volume.  
(Adjust microphone volume by rotating **MASTER VOLUME / MULTI JOG.**)

**5** **VOCAL EFFECTS**  
Selects voice filters (vocal effects) mode.

**6** **BASS BLAST**  
Press to select BASS effect directly.

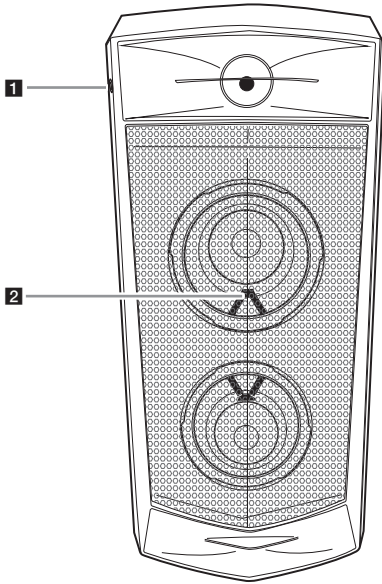

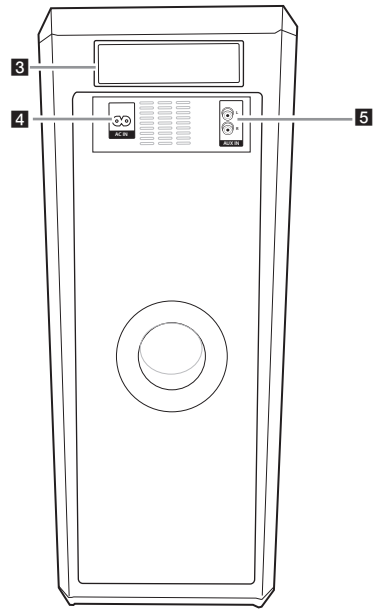

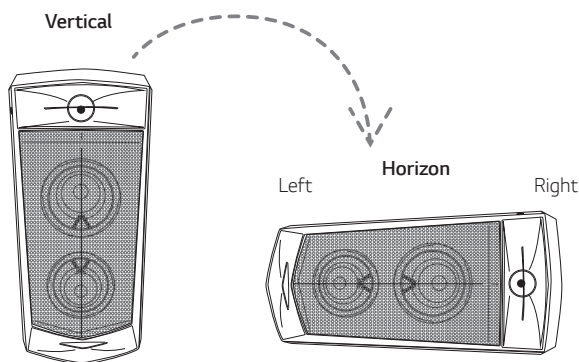

# How to place the unit

## Automatically optimize the sound

It helps automatically optimize the sound to suit the installation conditions (Horizontal or Vertical).

If the installation method is changed ('Horizontal → Vertical' or 'Vertical → Horizontal'), it is indicated by 'VERTICAL MODE' or 'HORIZON MODE' in the display panel.



### Note

On the horizon mode, you can hear the stereo sound and on the vertical mode, the sound transforms into a mono signal.

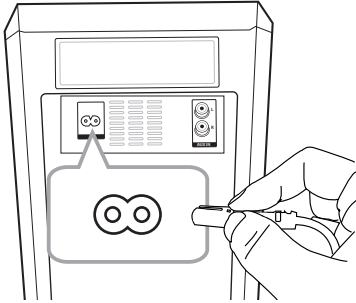


### Caution

- Do not sit on the unit or push the unit. Otherwise it may result in malfunction and cause personal injury and/or property damage.
- Do not place the unit in an unstable position. Place the unit at a safe distance from a child's reach.
- Be careful so that the unit does not fall down. Otherwise it may result in malfunction and cause personal injury and/or property damage.
- Watch out for the foot when you lay the unit in horizontally.

## AC Power Cord Connection

1. Connect one end of the AC power cord (included) to the AC IN socket.



2. Plug the other end into the wall outlet.

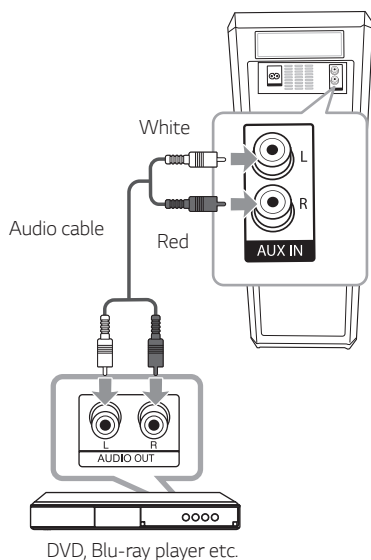
**Note**

Unplug the AC power cord from the wall outlet if you do not to use for an extended period of time.

## Optional Equipment Connection

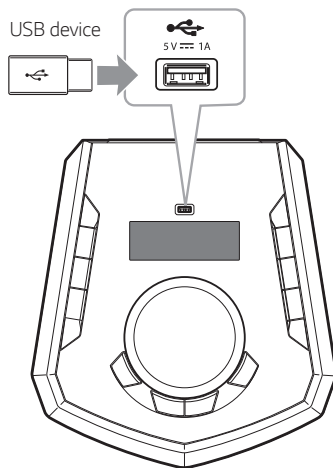
### AUX IN Connection

Connect an output of auxiliary device (Camcorder, TV, Player, etc) to the **AUX IN** (L/R) connector.



### USB Connection

Connect a USB device (or MP3 player, etc.) to the USB port on the unit.




#### ! Note

Removing the USB device from the unit :

1. Choose a different function.
2. Remove the USB device from the unit.

## Listening to music from your external device

The unit can be used to play music from many types of external devices.

1. Connect the external device to the **AUX IN** connector of the unit.
2. Turn the power on by pressing .
3. Press **F** to select AUX function.
4. Turn on the external device and start it playing.

# Basic Operations

## USB Operations

- 1. Connect the USB device to the USB port.
- 2. Select USB function by pressing F.

To	Do this
Playback	Press <b>▶  </b> on the remote control or <b>&gt;  </b> on the unit.
Pause	Press <b>▶  </b> on the remote control or <b>&gt;  </b> on the unit during playback.
Searching for a section within a file	Press and hold <b>◀◀/▶▶</b> on the remote control or <b> ◀◀/▶▶ </b> on the unit during playback and release it at the point you want to listen to.
Skipping to the next/previous file	Press <b>▶▶</b> on the remote control or <b>&gt;&gt; </b> on the unit to go to the next file.
	Playing less than 2 seconds, press <b>◀◀</b> on the remote control or <b> ◀◀</b> on the unit to go to the previous file. Playing after 3 seconds, press <b>◀◀</b> on the remote control or <b> ◀◀</b> on the unit to go to the beginning of the file.
Playing repeatedly or randomly	Press <b>REPEAT</b> on the remote control repeatedly.

- The display changes in the following order.

USB
*RPT 1
RPT**DIR
RPT ALL
RANDOM
OFF

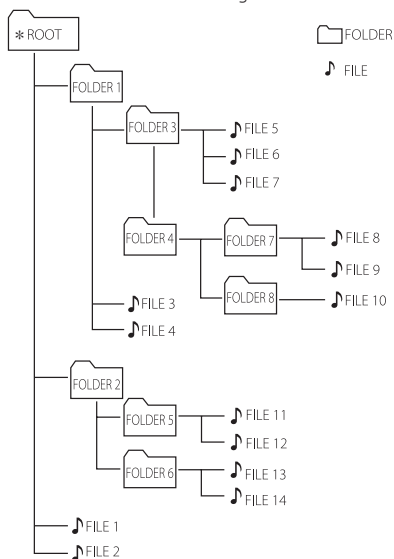
- \*RPT : Repeat  
\*\*DIR : Directory
- When you play JUKE BOX list, only RPT 1 and RPT ALL are available.
  - Even after restarting the unit or switching one function to another, you can listen to music from the point where it's last been played.

## Selecting a folder and an MP3/WMA file

1. Press **FOLDER**  $\wedge/\vee$  repeatedly on the remote control until a desired folder appears.
2. Press **▶||** to play it. The first file of folder will be played.

### ! Note

- USB Folders/Files are recognized as below.



- If there is no file in a folder, the folder will not appear.
- Folders will be presented as the following order,  
 ROOT → FOLDER 1 → FOLDER 3 →  
 FOLDER 7 → FOLDER 8 → FOLDER 5 →  
 FOLDER 6
- File will be played from  $\wedge$  file No.1 to  $\wedge$  file No.14 one by one.
- Files and folders will be presented in order recorded and may be presented differently according to the record circumstances.
- \*ROOT: The first screen you can see when a computer recognize the USB is "ROOT".



## Deleting a file/folder or format

You can delete a file or folder on your USB or you can format the USB.

1. Select USB function by pressing **F**.
2.
  - Deletes file: Select the file you want to delete and select "DEL FILE" by pressing **DELETE** on the remote control.
  - Deletes folder: Select the folder you want to delete and select "DEL DIR" by pressing **DELETE** on the remote control.
  - Formats USB: Select "FORMAT" by pressing **DELETE** on the remote control to format the USB device.
3. To delete file/folder or format, press and hold **DELETE** on the remote control.



### Caution

- Do not extract the USB device during operation, (such as play, delete, etc.).
- Regular back up is recommended to prevent data loss.
- The delete function may not be supported according to the USB status. (lock, etc.)

## Using BLUETOOTH® wireless technology

### About Bluetooth

**Bluetooth** is wireless communication technology for short range connection.

The sound may be interrupted when the connection interfered by the other electronic wave or you connect the **Bluetooth** in the other rooms.

Connecting individual devices under **Bluetooth** wireless technology does not incur any charges. A mobile phone with **Bluetooth** wireless technology can be operated via the Cascade if the connection was made via **Bluetooth** wireless technology.

- Available Devices : Smart phone, MP3, Notebook, etc.
- Version : 4.0
- Codec : SBC

### Bluetooth Profiles

In order to use **Bluetooth** wireless technology, devices must be able to interpret certain profiles. This unit is compatible with following profile.  
A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile)

## Listening to music stored on the Bluetooth devices

### Pairing your unit and Bluetooth device

Before you start the pairing procedure, make sure the **Bluetooth** feature is activated on your **Bluetooth** device. Refer to your **Bluetooth** device's user guide. Once a pairing operation is performed, it does not need to be performed again.

1. Turn on the unit.

#### ! Note

When Bluetooth connection lock is activated, you can search **Bluetooth** device in BT function.

2. Operate the **Bluetooth** device and perform the pairing operation. When searching for this unit with the **Bluetooth** device, a list of the devices found may appear in the **Bluetooth** device display depending on the type of **Bluetooth** device. Your unit appears as "LG FJ5 (XX)".

#### ! Note

- XX means the last two digits of **Bluetooth** address. For example, if your unit has a **Bluetooth** address such as 9C:02:98:4A:F7:08, you will see "LG FJ5 (08)" on your **Bluetooth** device.
- Depending on the **Bluetooth** device type, some devices may have a different pairing process. Enter the PIN code (0000) as needed.
- You can connect this unit with up to 3 **Bluetooth** devices simultaneously using the same method as described above, only in the **Bluetooth** function.
- The multi pairing connection is only supported on Android devices. (Multi pairing connection may not be supported depending on the connected device specifications.)
- Removable/detachable **Bluetooth** devices (Ex: Dongle etc.) will not support multi pairing.

3. When this unit is successfully connected with your **Bluetooth** device, "PAIRED" appears on the display window and change to **Bluetooth** device name soon. Then "BT" will appear on the display window.



### Note

- "PAIRED" will momentarily appear on the display when you connect other devices for multi pairing.
- If the device name is unavailable, " \_ " will be displayed.

4. Listen to music.

To play a music stored on your **Bluetooth** device, refer to your **Bluetooth** device's user guide.



### Note

- When using **Bluetooth** technology, you have to make a connection between the unit and the **Bluetooth** device as close as possible and keep the distance close.  
However, it may not work well in certain situations as described below:
  - There is an obstacle between the unit and the **Bluetooth** device.
  - There is a device using same frequency with **Bluetooth** technology such as a medical equipment, a microwave or a wireless LAN device.
- You should connect your **Bluetooth** device to this unit again when you restart it.
- Even if this unit connected up to 3 **Bluetooth** devices in the **Bluetooth** mode, you can play and control music by using only one of the connected devices.

## Controls connected Bluetooth device

You can control connected Bluetooth device by the unit; play, pause, stop, skip.



### Note

- Only Android OS and iOS is available to use this function.
- This function may not be supported depending on the **Bluetooth** device, or operated differently.

## Bluetooth connection lock (BT LOCK)

You can limit **Bluetooth** connections to only BT (**Bluetooth**) and LG TV function to prevent unintended **Bluetooth** connections.

To turn this function On, press and hold ►|| on the remote control or ►|| on the unit for about 5 seconds in BT (**Bluetooth**) function. "BT LOCK" appears then you can limit **Bluetooth** connections.

To turn off this function, press and hold ►|| on the remote control or ►|| on the unit for about 5 seconds in BT (**Bluetooth**) function. "BT UNLOCK" appears.

**Note**

- The sound may be interrupted when the connection has interference from other electronic devices.
- Depending on the type of the device, you may not be able to use the **Bluetooth** function.
- You can enjoy wireless system using phone, MP3, Notebook, etc.
- The more distance between the unit and the **Bluetooth** device, the lower the sound quality becomes.
- **Bluetooth** connection will be disconnected when the unit is turned off or the **Bluetooth** device gets too far from the unit.
- When **Bluetooth** connection is disconnected, connect the **Bluetooth** device to the unit again.
- When a **Bluetooth** device is not connected, "BT READY" appears on the display window.
- When you use the **Bluetooth** function, adjust the volume to a proper level on the **Bluetooth** device.
- If a **Bluetooth** device is connected when using LG TV, LG TV is disconnected and the **Bluetooth** device is connected.
- When you connect a Bluetooth device (iOS device etc.) to this unit or operate the device, the volume level can be synchronized with each other.
- The **Bluetooth** connection will be disconnected when you change the **Bluetooth** function to the others. In "Music Flow Bluetooth" app connection, only one device which you are playing keeps **Bluetooth** connection. You can control the **Bluetooth** device with this unit but you cannot use sound output.
- When entering the **Bluetooth** function, this unit automatically connects to **Bluetooth** the last device which was connected. (Auto connection may not be supported depending on the connected device specifications.)

## Using the Music Flow Bluetooth App

### ! Note

- Only Android OS is available to use "Music Flow Bluetooth" app with this unit.
- It is recommended to use the latest version of app.

## About "Music Flow Bluetooth" App

"Music Flow Bluetooth" app brings a suite of new features to this unit.

To enjoy more features, you are recommended to download and install free "Music Flow Bluetooth" app.

Here is introduce a few of the many features of "Music Flow Bluetooth" app.

**Multi Juke box:** Your entertainment increases three fold when you connect up to 3 **Bluetooth** phones at the same time. Play music from all three phone and create a customized playlist from all the phones.

## Install "Music Flow Bluetooth" App onto Your Bluetooth Device

There are two ways to install "Music Flow Bluetooth" App onto Your **Bluetooth** Device.

### Install "Music Flow Bluetooth" App through QR code

1. Install "Music Flow Bluetooth" app through QR code. Use the scanning software to scan the QR code.



2. Tap an icon for installation.

### ! Note

- Make sure that your **Bluetooth** device is connected to the Internet.
- Make sure that your **Bluetooth** device has a scanning software application. If you don't have one, download one from "Google Android Market (Google Play Store)".
- Depending on the area, QR code may not work.

## Install “Music Flow Bluetooth” App through “Google Android Market (Google Play Store)”

1. Tap the “Google Android Market (Google Play Store)” icon.
2. In the search bar, type in the “Music Flow Bluetooth” and search it.
3. In the search result list, find and tap “Music Flow Bluetooth” to start downloading **Bluetooth** app.
4. Tap an icon for installation.
5. Tap an icon for downloading.



### Note

- Make sure that your **Bluetooth** device is connected to the Internet.
- Make sure that your **Bluetooth** device is equipped with “Google Android Market (Google Play Store)”.

## Activate Bluetooth with “Music Flow Bluetooth” App

“Music Flow Bluetooth” app helps to connect your **Bluetooth** device to this unit.

1. Tap “Music Flow Bluetooth” app icon on the home screen to open “Music Flow Bluetooth” app, and go to the main menu.
2. If you want to get more information to operate, tap [Setting] and tap [Help] menu.



### Note

- “Music Flow Bluetooth” app will be available in the software version as follow;
  - Android O/S : Ver 4.0.3 (or later)
- If you use “Music Flow Bluetooth” app for operation, there would be some differences between “Music Flow Bluetooth” app and the supplied remote control. Use the supplied remote control as necessary.
- Depending on the **Bluetooth** device, “Music Flow Bluetooth” app may not work.
- After connection of “Music Flow Bluetooth” app, music may be output from your device. In this case, try connecting procedure again.
- If you operate the other applications or change the settings on your **Bluetooth** device while using “Music Flow Bluetooth” app, “Music Flow Bluetooth” app may operate abnormally.
- When “Music Flow Bluetooth” app operates abnormally, check your **Bluetooth** device and the connection of “Music Flow Bluetooth” app and then try to connect again.
- Depending on the smart phone's operating system, you have some differences for “Music Flow Bluetooth” operation.
- Check **Bluetooth** setting on your **Bluetooth** device if “Music Flow Bluetooth” app connection does not work well.

# Sound adjustment

## Setting the sound mode

This system has a number of pre-set surround sound fields. The displayed items for the equalizer may be different depending on sound sources and effects.

You can select a desired sound mode by using **SOUND EFFECT** on the remote control.

On Display	Description
BASS (BASS BLAST)	Reinforces the bass and powerful sound.
POP CLASSIC ROCK JAZZ	This program lends an enthusiastic atmosphere to the sound, giving you the feeling you are at an actual rock, pop, jazz or classic concert.
STANDARD	You can enjoy optimized sound.



### Note

You can directly select BASS (BASS BLAST) effect by pressing **BASS BLAST**.

## JUKE BOX Playback

JUKE BOX function enables you to make a playlist of your favorite files from a USB device.  
A playlist of up to 100 files can be entered.

### Making JUKE BOX list

1. Press and hold **JUKEBOX** on the remote control to enter the edit mode.  
(Playing will be stopped when you press **JUKEBOX** on the remote control.)
2. Select a file by pressing **◀◀/▶▶** on the remote control.
3. Press **JUKEBOX** on the remote control to save the file.
4. Repeat steps 2 - 3 to store other files.  
(You can modify the list by pressing **FOLDER ▲/▼** on the remote control to select the JUKE BOX program number.)
5. Press **JUKEBOX** on the remote control once again.

To play the JUKE BOX list, press **▶▶** on the remote control or **>||** on the unit after you make the list.



#### Note

When making or modifying the JUKE BOX list, REPEAT mode is off.

### Enjoying JUKE BOX

Press **JUKEBOX** on the remote control once. "JUKE BOX ON" appears on the display window.

To play JUKE BOX list, press **▶▶** on the remote control or **>||** on the unit.

To cancel it, press **JUKEBOX** on the remote control once.

"JUKE BOX OFF" appears on the display window.

### Editing JUKE BOX

1. Press and hold **JUKE BOX** on the unit to enter the edit mode.  
(Playing will be stopped when you press **JUKEBOX** on the remote control.)
2. Press **FOLDER ▲/▼** on the remote control to select a file to edit.
3. Press **◀◀/▶▶** on the remote control or **◀◀/▶▶** on the unit.
4. Press **JUKEBOX** on the remote control.
5. Repeat 2 to 4 to store the other files.
6. Press **JUKEBOX** on the remote control once again.

To play the JUKE BOX list, press **▶▶** on the remote control or **>||** on the unit after you edit the list.

### Deleting JUKE BOX list

Deleting function only works in the edit mode.

1. Press and hold **JUKEBOX** on the remote control to enter the edit mode.
2. Select a song by pressing **FOLDER ▲/▼** on the remote control repeatedly.
3. Press **DELETE** on the remote control while a song is selected.



#### Note

- If there is no JUKE BOX list, "JUKE BOX NONE" appears on the display window when you press **JUKEBOX** on the remote control.
- JUKE BOX is switched off in the case below.
  - Changing to a different function.
  - Turning off and on the unit.
- JUKE BOX list is cleared in the case below.
  - Removing the USB device.
  - Deleting music files in the USB device.




## Other Operations

### Turn off the sound temporarily

Press  on the remote control to mute your sound.

You can mute your unit, for example, to answer the telephone, the "MUTE" will appear in the display window.

To cancel it, press  on the remote control again or change the volume level.

### Displaying file information (ID3 TAG)

While playing an MP3 file containing file information, you can display the information by pressing **INFO** on the remote control.

In the power off state, press **ECHO/DEMO** on the unit once. The unit will power on and display the each of functions with demo sound in the display window. To cancel the DEMO function, press **ECHO/DEMO** on the unit once more.

### Note

You can enjoy other functions during the DEMO, the DEMO will temporarily pause.

- Without input key in 10 sec, the DEMO will play back automatically.

## Using Microphone

1. Connect your microphone to the MIC jack.
2. Play the music you want.
3. Sing along with the accompaniment. Adjust the microphone volume by pressing **MIC VOL.** and then turning **MASTER VOLUME/MULTI JOG** on the unit.

### ! Note

- When not using the microphone, set the MIC volume to minimum or turn off the MIC and remove the microphone from the MIC jack.
- If the microphone is set too near the speaker, a howling sound may be produced. In this case, move the microphone away from the speaker or decrease the sound level by using the **MIC VOL.** on the unit.
- If sound through the microphone is extremely loud, it may be distorted. In this case, rotate **MIC VOL.** on the unit to minimum.
- You can give an echo effect to the sound from the microphones by pressing **ECHO/DEMO.**

## VOICE CANCELLER

You can enjoy the function while playing the music, by reducing singer vocal of music in the various source.

Press the **VOICE CANCELLER** and "ON" will appear in display window.

To cancel it, press **VOICE CANCELLER** again.

The quality of the VOICE CANCELLER may be different depending on the recording conditions of music files.

### ! Note

- This function is available USB or BT (**Bluetooth**) Function.
- If the function is not available, "NOT SUPPORT" appears in the display window.
- This function is available to use only when a microphone is connected.
- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.
- It is not available on the mono source.
- To initialize it, change the function or disconnect the microphone.
- This function may not be initialized depending on the status of connected devices.

## KEY CHANGER

You can adjust the key to 9 steps (4 steps higher, 4 steps lower and the original key).

- To sharp the key one by one, press the **# KEY CHANGER** repeatedly during playback.
- To flatten the key one by one, press the **b KEY CHANGER** repeatedly during playback.

### ! Note

- This function is available for USB or BT (Bluetooth) function.
- To initialize it, change the function, disconnect the microphone or change the music.
- This function may not be initialized depending on the status of connected devices.
- If the function is not available, "NOT SUPPORT" appears in the display window.
- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.

## VOICE FILTERS (VOCAL EFFECTS)

When you connect your microphone to the MIC jack, you can enjoy karaoke function by changing voice in the various source.

To select various mode, pressing **VOCAL EFFECTS** repeatedly or pressing **VOCAL EFFECTS** and then turning **MASTER VOLUME/MULTI JOG** on the unit when voice filters(vocal effects) mode appears in the display window.

BASS → SOPRANO → HELIUM → ROBOT →  
DUET MAN → DUET WOMAN → BASS ECHO1  
→ SOPRANO ECHO1 → HELIUM ECHO1  
→ ROBOT ECHO1 → DUET MAN1 → DUET  
WOMAN1 → BASS ECHO2 → SOPRANO  
ECHO2 → HELIUM ECHO2 → ROBOT ECHO2  
→ DUET MAN2 → DUET WOMAN2 → OFF

### ! Note

- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.
- If you press **KEY CHANGER** or **ECHO/DEMO** on the unit on voice filters(vocal effects) mode, after backing up current voice filters(vocal effects), turn off voice filters(vocal effects) mode and operate **KEY CHANGER** or **ECHO/DEMO** mode.
- To turn off voice filters(vocal effects) mode, press and hold **VOCAL EFFECTS**.

## ECHO

When you connect your microphone to the MIC jack, you can give an echo effect to the sound from the microphones by pressing **ECHO/DEMO**.

ECHO 1 → ECHO 2 → ECHO OFF

### ! Note

- If a microphone is not connected, "INSERT MIC" appears in the display window.
- If you press **VOCAL EFFECTS** button on ECHO mode, after backing up current ECHO, turn off ECHO mode and operate voice filters(vocal effects) mode. Press **ECHO/DEMO** again, after backing up current voice filters(vocal effects), operate ECHO mode.

## LIGHTING

This function offers a party atmosphere by operating the lighting on the unit.

1. Press **LIGHTING** on the unit.
2. Select the mode by turning **MASTER VOLUME/MULTI JOG** or press **LIGHTING** repeatedly on the unit.  
PARTY → PEACEFUL → ROMANTIC → COOL → UPBEAT → FIERY → EXCITED → DYNAMIC → HEALING → SUNNY → OFF

### ! Note

- Lighting function is available in all functions.
- Lighting mode retains its previous mode when you first press **LIGHTING** on the unit, press again to change modes.

## Auto power down

This unit will turn itself off to save electricity in the case were the main unit is not connected to an external device and is not used for 15 minutes. The unit will also turn itself off after six hours if the main unit has been connected to another device using the analog inputs.

Auto power down function is applied to only MASTER (Primary) unit in case of WIRELESS PARTY LINK connection. In case of SLAVE (Secondary) unit, Auto power down is available after disconnection SLAVE (Secondary) unit and MASTER (Primary) unit.

## AUTO POWER On

This unit automatically turns on by an input source : LG TV or **Bluetooth**

When you turn on your TV connected to this unit, this unit recognizes the input signal and selects the suitable function. You can hear the sound from the unit.

If you try to connect your **Bluetooth** device, this unit turns on and connects your **Bluetooth** device. You can play your music.

### ! Note

- Depending on the connected device, this function may not operate.
- Depending on the connected device, the unit turns on but **Bluetooth** function may not be connected.
- If you disconnect **Bluetooth** connection by this unit, some **Bluetooth** devices try to connect to the unit continually. Therefore it is recommended to disconnect the connection before turning off the unit.
- If you try to connect to the "Music Flow Bluetooth" app, **Bluetooth** function of this unit is turned on.
- If you turn on the unit using LG TV or **Bluetooth** function, proper function of this unit is turned on.
- If you have already paired with this unit, automatically this unit can turn on by an input source when this unit is turned off.
- If you turn off the unit by pressing the power button for more than 5 seconds, Auto Power On function is disabled. To activate it, turn on the unit.

## Auto function change

This unit recognizes input signals such as **Bluetooth** and LG TV, and then changes suitable function automatically.

### When you try to connect Bluetooth device

When you try to connect your **Bluetooth** device to this unit, **Bluetooth** function is selected. Play your music on the **Bluetooth** device.

### When LG TV is connected

When you turn on your LG TV connected by LG Sound Sync, this unit changes the function to LG TV. You can hear the sound from your TV.

### ! Note

- This function is not available during deleting.
- This function only works with devices that were previously connected.
- If the **Bluetooth** connection lock function is set, **Bluetooth** and LG TV connection will be only available on **Bluetooth** and LG TV function.

## LG Sound Sync



You can control some functions of this unit by your TV's remote control with LG Sound Sync. It is compatible with LG TV that supports LG Sound Sync. Make sure your TV has the LG Sound Sync logo.

Controllable function by LG TV's remote control :  
Volume up/down, mute

Refer to the TV's instruction manual for the details of LG Sound Sync.

1. Turn on the unit by pressing .
2. Press **F** until LG TV function is selected.
3. Set up the sound output of TV to listen to the sound through this unit :  
TV setting menu [Sound] → [TV Sound output] → [LG Sound Sync (Wireless)]  
"PAIRED" appears on the display window for about 3 seconds and then you can see "LG TV" on the display window if the TV and this unit are connected normally.

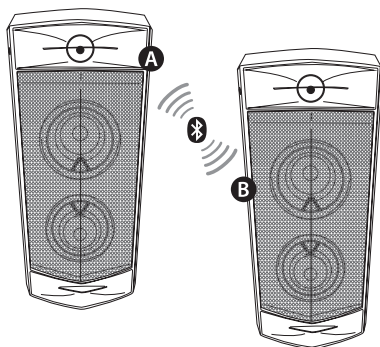
### Note

- You can also use the remote control of this unit while using LG Sound Sync. If you use TV's remote control again, the unit synchronizes with the TV.
- If the connection fails, check the conditions of this unit and your TV: power, function.
- Make sure of the condition of this unit and the connection in the cases below when using LG Sound Sync.
  - The unit is turned off.
  - Changing to a different function.
  - Disconnecting the wireless connection caused by interference or a distance.
- The amount of time to turn off this unit is different depending on your TV.
- If you try to change the function on using the LG TV function, volume will be change according to the LG TV volume level.
- Details of TV setting menu vary depending on the manufacturers or models of your TV.
- If you connect LG Sound Sync when "Music Flow Bluetooth" app is connected, control through the app is available.
- If you turned off the unit directly by pressing , LG Sound Sync will be disconnected. To use this function again, you should reconnect the TV and the unit.
- If an LG TV is connected when using **Bluetooth, Bluetooth** is disconnected and the LG TV is connected.
- The volume may be increased when the TV and this unit is connected by LG Sound Sync. Decrease the TV volume and then connect with this unit.
- When you turn on your LG TV connected by LG Sound Sync or enter LG TV function, this unit changes the function to LG TV automatically.
- You should set the TV Sound output manually depending on the LG TV version.

## WIRELESS PARTY LINK Connection

The output sound of **A**(MASTER (Primary)) unit is expanded to **B**(SLAVE (Secondary)) unit. It is compatible with unit that supports WIRELESS PARTY LINK.

The name of function about sound expansion between the compatible products wired or wirelessly was changed to PARTY LINK or WIRELESS PARTY LINK.



1. Press **WIRELESS LINK** on the unit. PARTY LINK MODE SELECT appears in the display window.
2. Press **WIRELESS LINK** on the unit to select MASTER (Primary) or SLAVE (Secondary).
  - **A** unit : Selects MASTER (Primary).
  - **B** unit : Selects SLAVE (Secondary).

Two units try to connect with each other.
3. When these units are successfully connected each other, "Slave (Secondary) Device Name CONNECTED" appears in the MASTER (Primary) unit.  
"CONNECTED TO Master (Primary) Device Name" appears in the SLAVE (Secondary) unit and changes to SLAVE (Secondary) soon.

### ! Note

- If you using the LG Sound Sync, this function is not available. If you connect the LG TV function, "NOT SUPPORT" appears in the display window.
- You can use microphone in the SLAVE (Secondary) unit only. In case of SLAVE (Secondary) unit, some functions are supported only.
- When WIRELESS PARTY LINK is disconnected, SLAVE (Secondary) unit is changed to BT function.
- If the connection is failed, "FAILED" appears in the display window.
- Mute function is synchronized with each other.
- WIRELESS PARTY LINK connection will be disconnected when you turn off the unit or press **WIRELESS LINK** on the unit.
- Sound of MASTER (Primary) unit and SLAVE (Secondary) unit may be different depending on playback status or source.
- Check the following information when connecting to **Bluetooth**.
  - You can connect only one **Bluetooth** device in the MASTER (Primary) unit. You cannot connect **Bluetooth** device to the SLAVE (Secondary) unit.
  - WIRELESS PARTY LINK connection is only supported on Android devices. (WIRELESS PARTY LINK connection may not be supported depending on the connected device specifications or OS.)
  - Removable/detachable **Bluetooth** devices (ex. Dongle etc.) will not support WIRELESS PARTY LINK connection.
  - When WIRELESS PARTY LINK is connected, **Bluetooth** connection is not available in status of deleting.

# Troubleshooting


Problem	Cause & Solution
The unit does not work properly.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Turn off the power of this unit and the connected external device (TV, Woofer, DVD-player, Amplifier, etc.) and turn them on again.</li><li>• Disconnect the power cord of this unit and the connected external device (TV, Woofer, DVD-player, Amplifier, etc.) and then try connecting again.</li><li>• Previous setting may not be saved when device power is shut off.</li></ul>
No Power:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The power cord is not plugged in. Plug in the power cord.</li><li>• Check whether electricity failed. Check the condition by operating other electronic devices.</li></ul>
No sound.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Check whether you select right function. Press function button and check the selected function.</li></ul>
The remote control does not work properly.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The remote control is too far from the unit. Operate the remote control within about 7 m (23 feet).</li><li>• There is an obstacle in the path of the remote control and the unit. Remove the obstacle.</li><li>• The batteries in the remote control are exhausted. Replace the batteries with new ones.</li></ul>
No speaker light.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Check the light effects by pressing <b>LIGHTING</b>.</li></ul>
LG Sound Sync does not work.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Check whether your LG TV supports LG Sound Sync.</li><li>• Check connection of LG Sound Sync.</li><li>• Check sound setting of your TV and this unit.</li></ul>

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## Maintenance

### Handling the Unit

#### When shipping the unit

Please save the original shipping carton and packing materials. If you need to ship the unit, for maximum protection, re-pack the unit as it was originally packed at the factory.

#### Keeping the exterior surfaces clean
