
IMPORTANT

Insert Cam Lock Screws into the pre-drilled holes of Side Panel (B) and (C).











Attach Front Piece (D) to Side Panel (B) with 1" Round Head Screws. (See figure 1)




Attach Back Pieces (F) & Base Piece (H) to Side Panel (B) using Cam Locks. (See figure 2)





Attach Front Piece (D) to Side Panel (C) with 1" Round Head Screws. (See figure 3)








STEP 2

Insert Base Part (I5) into the groove.


Attach Side Part (I4) to Front Part (I1) and Back Part (I2) using a Phillips screwdriver and 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.







Attach Small Pull Handles with machine screws.




STEP 1

Loosen slighty the lower screws.




STEP 2


Insert the drawer into the main body, then adjust the drawer front panel left or right and up or down, until the drawer gaps look proportional.




II. IF THE DRAWER ALREADY ALIGNS
