

## PAIRING & DISCOVERING A NEW BLUETOOTH CONNECTION

1) Power on the *BM850AMPBT* by pressing and holding down the Play/Pause multifunction

button for 3 seconds, the blue LEDs will start to flash, signalling that the BM850AMPBT is now ready for Bluetooth pairing.

NOTE: You have 30 seconds before you must restart this procedure over again.

2) Now that the BM850AMPBT is in pairing mode:

- ANDROID users:
  a. Go into the Settings Menu of your device

  - 8. GO IND UTE SETTINGS WELLOW 1 YOU SHAPE

    C. TURN ON Bluetooth Menu
    C. TURN ON Bluetooth and press SCAN
    d. "BOSS BM850AMPBT" will now be displayed under AVAILABLE DEVICES
    e. Press "BOSS BM850AMPBT" to get Bluetooth connected

- iOS users:
  a. Go into the Settings Menu of your iOS device
  b. Enter the Bluetooth Menu

  - d. "BOSS BM850AMPBT" will now be displayed e. Press "BOSS BM850AMPBT" to get Bluetooth connected

3) If the BOSS BM850AMPBT is not seen, repeat the above steps to refresh the "Device List"


4) When the connection is successful, you are now ready to stream music from your favorite media player to the *BM850AMPBT* 



To avoid potential shorts in the electrical system, be sure to disconnect the (-) battery cable before installation. Use this unit with a 12-Volt battery and negative grouing only. Failure to do so may result in a fire or malfunction.

2) The unit will now automatically reconnect


3) If your device was previously paired with the BM850AMPBT, but it wasn't the last paired

- a. Ensure no other devices are currently paired
- b. Enter the Bluetooth Menu on your device being paired
  c. "BOSS BM850AMPBT" will display under AVAILABLE DEVICES
  d. Choose the "BOSS BM850AMPBT" to reconnect

4) If the device is out of range from the BM850AMPBT, it will disconnect automatically

- a. To reconnect once device is back in range, press the Play/Pause
- button once
  b. The BM850AMPBT will now reconnect to the device



GETTING TO KNOW YOUR
