DOOR SWING DIMENSIONS



Notes

The installation must allow for proper clearances to adjacent appliances, walls or cabinets. There should be no interference when doors are opened.

The space needed for the hinge and the distance to the adjacent cabinetry and its handle is shown with both 3/4" (19 mm) and 1 1/2" (38 mm) thick door panels.

If interference is an issue, the following solutions can be considered:

- Limit the door swing angle to 90° with a door stop pin inserted into the hinge.
- Install a spacer between the appliance and the opposing element that creates the interference.
- If the door panel thickness is larger than 3/4" (19mm), consider reducing it.
- Rearrange surrounding cabinetry or appliances to eliminate the interference.
- Create a protruding cutout for the appliance (see page 6 for "retrofit" installation).

INSTALLATION PLANNING - MULTIPLE COLUMNS

Integrated columns can be combined in cutout widths of 42", 48", 54" and 60".

- The SKSFJ800P Joining Kit is required between units (kit included with all freezer columns.)
- Reference the cutout dimensions for each column for detailed dimensions.
- A minimum 15 amp (115V, 60Hz) power supply is required for each individual column.
- A cold water supply is required for water dispenser and automatic icemaker operation for each applicable column.

INSTALLATION CLEARANCES - MULTIPLE COLUMNS WITH SAME DOOR SWING (HANDLE TO HINGE)

*When using the Stainless Steel Door Panel Kit w/Handle or 3/4" (19 mm) custom panels with our optional Brushed Aluminum Handle, a minimum spacer of 1 3/4" (44 mm) between units is required to open each door 115° without interference.

**When using the Stainless Steel Door Panel Kit w/Handle or 3/4" (19 mm) custom panels with our optional Brushed Aluminum Handle, a minimum spacer of 3/4" (19 mm) between units is required to open each door 90° without interference.

Notes

When installing multiple columns in a flush installation with the same door swing (handle to hinge), considerations must be made to avoid door swing interference. The examples shown assume a 3/4" panel and the Signature Kitchen Suite handle.

Door panel thickness, handle size / position and door swing range should always be considered when determining the size of the spacer in any installation. See page 6 for details on door swing dimensions for proper planning.

Integrated column appliances are designed to accommodate nearly any type of cabinetry door installation. The required cutout depth depends on the desired cabinetry and custom panel execution, whether North American styles that feature a face frame or European styles that are frameless.

Note: GFI (ground fault interrupter) is not recommended.

Water Line

A cold water supply is required for water dispenser and automatic icemaker operation for each individual column. Water pressure must be between 20 and 120 p.s.i.

Tubing should be long enough to extend to the front of the unit. Allow enough tubing to accommodate a bend leading into the water line connection.

Water line can enter an opening through floor or back wall.

Install a shut-off valve between the icemaker water valve and cold water supply in the home.

SKSFK800CS – Frame Kit

All units can be installed in a 24" (610 mm) deep cutout with an optional frame kit. This kit includes two 80" (2032 mm) brushed aluminum side trim pieces. Each trim piece is 5" (127 mm) deep with a 1/8" (3 mm) front face.

SKSFJ800P - Joining Kit for Dual/Multiple Column Installation

This kit is required for installation when a wine column is installed with another wine column, refrigerator column or French door column. This kit is included with all freezer columns.

Design Tips

The Stainless Steel Panel Kit may be used in a retrofit 24" (610 mm) cutout depth installation.

For retrofit / replacement installations where the existing cutout is 24" (610 mm) deep, the optional frame kit is recommended.
