



English

1 For desktop use

Screw the microphone into the threaded portion of the tripod desk stand. The front of the microphone should face the A-T logo. Extend the tripod legs to provide a wide, secure base, and place the tripod desk stand on a flat surface.

For mic stand use

Screw the microphone stand clamp to your mic stand. Screw microphone into the stand clamp.

2 Use a screwdriver or coin to loosen/tighten the stand's pivot screws for angle adjustment.

3 Plug one of the provided USB cables into the USB output at the base of the microphone then

connect the other end of the cable to your digital recording device.

When connecting the microphone to a USB-C port, you must use a USB On-The-Go (USB OTG) cable like the one included.

When using with equipment that includes a built-in mic, consult that device's user guide for instructions on disabling its mic.

4 Optional headphone monitoring: Connect headphones with 3.5 mm (1/8") plug into front of microphone. Use up/down buttons for volume control.

Français

1 Pour une utilisation sur table

Vissez le microphone sur la partie filetée du trépied. L'avant du microphone doit être orienté face au logo A-T. Allongez le trépied pour offrir une base large et sûre et placez-le sur une surface plane.

Pour une utilisation sur pied de microphone

Vissez la pince du microphone dans le pied du microphone. Vissez le microphone dans la pince.

2 Utilisez un tournevis ou une pièce pour serrer/desserrer les vis du pivot du pied afin de régler l'angle.

3 Branchez l'un des câbles USB fournis à la sortie USB à la base du microphone, puis connectez l'autre extrémité du câble à votre appareil d'enregistrement numérique.

Lorsque vous branchez le microphone à un port USB-C, vous devez utiliser un câble USB On-The-Go (USB OTG) comme celui inclus.

Lors de l'utilisation d'un équipement avec micro intégré, consultez le guide d'utilisation de cet appareil pour les instructions relatives à la désactivation de son micro.

4 Contrôle du casque en option : reliez les casques avec prise jack 3,5 mm dans la face avant du microphone. Utilisez les flèches vers le haut/bas pour régler le volume.

1 Para uso en escritorio

Enrosque el micrófono en la sección rosada del trípode de mesa. La parte frontal del micrófono debe estar situada frente al logotipo de A-T. Estienda las patas del trípode para proporcionar una base ancha y segura, y coloque el trípode de mesa sobre una superficie plana.

Para uso con pedestal para micro

Enrosque la abrazadera para pedestal del micrófono a su pedestal para micro. Enrosque el micrófono en la abrazadera para pedestal.

2 Utilice un destornillador o una moneda para aflojar/apretar los tornillos de pivot del soporte.

3 Enchufe uno de los cables USB incluidos en la salida USB de la base del micrófono y después conecte el

otro extremo del cable a su dispositivo de grabación digital.

Si conecta el micrófono a un puerto USB-C, debe utilizar un cable USB On-The-Go (USB OTG) como el que se incluye.

Si se utiliza con un equipo con un micro incorporado, consulte el manual de usuario del dispositivo para obtener instrucciones sobre cómo desactivarlo.

4 Monitorización con auriculares opcionales: conecte los auriculares con conector de 3,5 mm a la parte frontal del micrófono. Utilice los botones arriba/abajo para controlar el volumen.

1 Para uso em mesa

Rosqueie o microfone na porção rosada do pedestal de mesa com tripé. A parte frontal do microfone deve estar voltada para o logotipo A-T. Estenda as pernas do trípode para fornecer uma base ampla e segura, e coloque o pedestal de mesa com tripé em uma superfície plana.

Para uso com pedestal de microfone

Rosqueie o suporte para pedestal do microfone no pedestal do seu microfone. Rosqueie o microfone no suporte para pedestal.

2 Use uma chave de fenda ou moeda para soltar/apertar os parafusos pivô do pedestal para ajustar o ângulo.

3 Conecte um dos cabos USB fornecidos na saída USB da

base do microfone e, em seguida, conecte a outra extremidade do cabo no seu dispositivo de gravação digital.

Ao conectar o microfone a uma porta USB-C, você deve usar um cabo USB OTG (On-The-Go) como o que foi incluído.

Ao usar com equipamento que inclui um microfone embutido, consulte o guia do usuário desse dispositivo para obter instruções de como desativar seu microfone.

4 Monitoramento opcional de fones de ouvido: Conecte os fones de ouvido com plugue de 3,5 mm na parte frontal do microfone. Use os botões para cima/para baixo para controlar o volume.
