Instruction Manual

IMPORTANT INFORMATION READ BEFORE ASSEMBLING THIS PRODUCT

Follow the information on the warning appearing on the upper bunk end structure and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from bed.

Use only a mattress with the dimensions 74-75 in. L x 37 1/2 - 38 1/2 in. W x 7.5 in. H on the upper bunk. A mattress with the same dimensions is also recommended for the lower bunk.

Surface of mattress must be at least 5 inches (127mm) below the upper edge of guardrails. Mattress must not exceed the maximum thickness of 7.5 in.

Always use the recommended size mattreses or mattress supports, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls

The use of a water or sleep flotation mattress is prohibited.

Replacement parts, including additional guardrails, may be obtained from any of Walker Edison Furniture Company's dealers or by contacting us online at www.walkeredison.com.

DO NOT use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.

Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk.

If the bunk bed will be placed next to a wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and the wall.

Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.

Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.

DO NOT allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.

DO NOT allow horseplay on or under the bed. Prohibit jumping on the bed.

Prohibit more than one person on the upper bunk.


The use of a night light may provide an added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.

STRANGULATION HAZARD – Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed. For example, but not limited to hooks, belts or jump ropes.

When using this item in the bunk bed configuration, use bed with the warning stickers as the bottom bunk.




Twin over Twin Bunk Bed














Use Hex key (K) to attach parts (3, 5, 8, 20) together using screw (G) and bolt (B)





Use Hex key (K) to attach parts (1, 2, 6, 7) together using screw (G) and bolt (B). Do this step twice.


































Conversion into Two Single Twin Beds




Loosen the appropriate hardware and remove the ladder from the bunk bed assembly.
