





- Do not tighten all the screws until each part is properly assembled.
- Keep Hex Wrench as the Head Cap Bolts may need to be tightened in the future.



Pull out Shelf (B) from Top (A).

Insert Cam Lock Screws into pre-drilled holes in Top (A) and Side Panels (C), (D), then tighten.




STEP 2

Attach Back Rails (F) to Side Panel (C) with Cam Locks. (See Figure 1)


Slide Back Panel (G) into position.

Attach Front Rails (E) to unit with Cam Locks.

Attach Side Panel (D) to unit with Cam Locks.



STEP 3


Attach Bottom (H) to unit with 1 1/4" Round Head Screws and Dowels.



STEP 4

Attach Frame Legs (I) to unit with Head Cap Bolts.

Tighten all bolts with Hex Wrench. (See Figure 2)





Attach Top (A) to unit with Cam Locks and Dowels.

Slide Shelf (B) into Top (A) of unit.

Attach Stopper with 1/2" Flat Head Screw into pre-drilled hole in Shelf (B).

Drawer (J)






STEP 8


Attach Drawer Side (J3) to Drawer Front (J1) and Drawer Back (J2) with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.

STEP 9

Insert Drawer Bottom (J5) into groove.


Attach Drawer Side (J4) to unit with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.





Attach Handle with Machine Screw.


Note: Drawer assembly is not complete until 3/4" Flat Head Screws are used in a later step.


STEP 11

Loosen slightly the screws pre-installed on back of drawer front.



STEP 12

Insert drawer into unit, then adjust drawer front panel left or right and up or down until drawer gaps look proportional.




STEP 13

Pull drawer open slowly and re-tighten screws from Step 11.

Make sure drawer front panel does not move and lock drawer front panel into position with 3/4" Flat Head Screws.


Note: These 3/4" Flat Head Screws must be installed to complete the drawer assembly.

STEP 14

Slide Drawer (J) into place.
